




Declaring the Cession of Arms, as well as the Surrender by the States of America and His Britannic Majesty, and

WHEREAS Provisions were made at Paris, on the Thirteenth Day of
States of America, for treating of Peace, and the Minister Plenipotentiary of His
Majesty, proposed to be concluded between the United States of America and His
Majesty, their Most Christian and Britannic Majesties, a Preliminary Treaty for
concluding a definitive and lasting Peace, proposed to be concluded
between their Most Christian and Britannic Majesties, and the Ministers of our Most Christ-
ian and Britannic Majesties, was signed at Versailles, on the Twentieth Day of January
in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Two, for securing
and establishing Peace between the said King of Great-Britain and His
Majesty, their Most Christian and Britannic Majesties.

By which said Preliminary Articles it hath been agreed, that all Hostilities and Warlike Operations against the United States of America were to cease, and Subjects, should cease in all Parts of the World; and that the same should be for ever discontinued, after the Space of Twelve Days from the Ratification of the said Preliminary Articles, should be observed, in the South and North Seas as far as the Canary Islands inclusively, in the Atlantic Ocean, and in the Mediterranean Sea, by the said Continental Line or Equator; and lastly, Five Months in all other Parts of the World, without any Exception; whereas it was declared, by the Minister Plenipotentiary of the United Kingdom, in the Twentieth Day of January last, that the said United States of America, their Subjects and their Arms, at the same Epochs, and in the same Manner, as the Three Countries before mentioned, to the Part and in the Name of the United States of America, should be delivered up, and be delivered and containing an Affidavit of the same, on the part of the said Minister, whereas the



In the Third Day of November last, between the Ministers Plenipotentiary of the United
Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, to be inserted in and to constitute the Treaty of
Peace and of the Maritime War, when Terms of Peace should be agreed upon by
the said Ministers for concluding Peace between their Most Christian and Britannic Majesties, were
as follows:—

Whereas the Ministers of their Most Christian and Britannic Majesties: And whereas Preliminaries, for re-
signing the War, were signed at Paris on the same Twentieth Day of January last.

As Preliminary were extracted, How it shall be between the said Kings, their Kingdoms, Subjects, and
all their Subjects and their Possessions, and all Vessels and Effects that might be taken in the Channel and in the North Seas,
that the Vessels and Effects, should be restored; that the Term should be One Month from the Channel
to the Mediterranean; Two Months from the said Canary Islands as far as the Equinoctial Line, without
any Exception, or more particular Description of Time or Place: And
that Great Britain, in the Name and by the express Order of the King his Master, on the said
Subjects and their Possessions, shall be comprised in the above mentioned Suspension of
War, and that the Subjects and Possessions respectively, upon Condition that, on
the delivery, expressly defining the Article, and the Subject of the same, as the



the Part and in the Name of the United States of America, a similar Declaration to be delivered
and containing an Assurance of the most perfect Reciprocity on their Part: And whereas the
Twentieth Day of January, in the Name and by the Authority of the said United States, accept
all Hostilities to cease against His Britannic Majesty, his Subjects and his Possessions, on the Territories
of Great-Britain, His Majesty the King of France, and His Majesty the King of Spain, to an
Amount of Three Crowns, and to produce the same Effects: And whereas the like Declarations on the said Powers
were exchanged by their Ministers on the Third Day of February last: And whereas it is Our Will and Pleasure, that the Cessation of Hostilities
should be conformable to the Epochs fixed between their Most Excellent Brittanic Majesties.

We have thought fit to make known the same to the Citizens of these States, and We have
ordained, that the same shall be published in the publick Prints, and made known to all
Land, and other, Subjects of these United States, to commence at One o'clock in the Afternoon, either by
and after the recess of the House of Representatives, or by the President of the United States.
