Whereas by the Act 57 Victoria, cap. 20, intituled "An Act respecting the Apprepriation of certain Deminion Lands in Manitoba," it is provided that each and every person new resident in the said Province, being Original White Settlers who came into the Red River country, whether under the anspices of Lord Selkirk or otherwise, between the years One thousand eight hundred and thirteen and One thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, both inclusive, or the children (not being Half-breeds) of such Original White Settlers, shall be entitled, under regulations to be made by the Governor General in Council, to receive scrip for \$160, the same to be receivable in payment for the purchase of Dominion lands; and that each Half-breed head of a family, resident in the said Province on the 15th day of July, 1870, shall be entitled, in the discretion of and under regulations to be made by the Governor General in Council, to receive a grant of 160 acres of land, or to receive scrip for \$160, receivable as aforesaid. And Whereas the list of names which are subjoined appear, from the Census which has been obtained by authority, as those of persons in the Province answering to the descriptions respectively above recited, Public Notice is hereby given that a Commissioner will attend at
