

Committed for trial! A simple for-
mula, but full of terrible significance.
It means that a grave, sober-minded, ex-
perienced, and impartial jurist, learned
in the law and exceptionally conversant
with prison facts, evidence as regards or-
derly cases, entertains very serious doubts
of the innocence of the unfortunate being
then standing in his presence, and charged
with the perpetration of an offense too
heinous to be dealt with summarily. To
certain extent it is a sentence of con-
demnation. An individual who has so
conducted himself as to incur the suspi-
cion of guilt not only on the part of reputable
witnesses, but also on that of the presiding
magistrate, must at least have been guilty
of some crime. Can he be innocent? He
is in whose direction one would be un-
willing to place over-much confidence. There
is only one exception to be made, and that
is in a case of mistaken identity. Even
then, perhaps, a genuine outburst, said he,
"who has invented a sailing apparatus for
a wagon and sweeps over the prairies with
it at the rate of sixty to seventy miles an
