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

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

Ground Ginger and a Study of Analytical Results.

SIR,—I have the honour to submit a report on Ground Ginger as sold in Canada. This report deals with 259 samples, purchased in November and December of 1913, and in January of this year.

Ginger has been inspected on five occasions, before the present; and has always been found to be more or less adulterated, as shown by the following record:—

The adulteration referred to in the above tabulation may be called *gross*, inasmuch as it consists, mainly of added foreign material, viz.: starches or flour, turmeric, cayenne or mineral matter.

A more subtle form of adulteration, namely, the intermixture or substitution of exhausted ginger, has for the most part escaped penalization. Exhausted ginger is ginger from which the components which give the article value as a spice have been extracted. After extraction, the residual tissues retain their characteristic forms and the starch may be so little altered as to be indistinguishable from normal ginger starch. As a spice, this residue possesses practically no value, and should not be

found on the market except perhaps as an ingredient in Cattle Foods, where it may possibly find legitimate use, although even this is doubtful. It is however quoted in many wholesale price lists, and I find one of this year, offering Spent Ginger at 4 cents f.o.b. Montreal, while genuine ginger is quoted at 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents.

It will be readily understood that the availability of this comparatively useless article offers a great temptation to grinders; and there can be no doubt whatever that many samples reported herewith, as well as in former bulletins, consist in part of the spent ginger, or exhausted ginger above referred to.

The difficulty of detection lies in the fact that the characteristic microscopic structure remains unaltered, and even the chemical characters are so little changed that a considerable percentage of spent ginger may be added to a good quality of genuine ginger without modifying the specific constants to such an extent as to justify the analyst in declaring the sample adulterated.

The only effective way of meeting the case would seem to be the establishing of standards for moisture, total and water soluble ash, and extractive matters, beyond which a sample should be declared illegal.

This alternative has been kept in view from the first, and I am of opinion that the data which we have accumulated since 1897, will be found sufficient basis for standardization of commercial ground ginger.

The moisture content varies from about 6.5 to 10 per cent so far as the present report is concerned. Somewhat higher numbers were found in 1897 (Bull. 48), 1904 (Bull. 95), while distinctly lower percentages of water were found in 1906 (Bull. 137). It is however quite unusual to find less than 7 per cent of water in genuine ginger. This datum is of little value, considered in itself, but in its relation to total extractive by cold water, it must be regarded as essential.

The ash content of ginger depends much upon the way in which the rhizomes are cleaned before grinding, and is of course, greatly influenced by the presence of lime used as a coating of the rhizome. This practice is quite common, and must be held to account for the extremely variable amounts of total mineral residue obtained on incineration.

The most important datum for judging adulteration by addition of spent ginger is the percentage of cold water extractive.

The exhaustion of ginger by water entails loss of soluble salts, and consequent reduction of water soluble ash; so that a lowered water extractive is usually accompanied by a lowered soluble ash. The following study illustrates the effect of previous extraction upon the ash percentage.

Four samples of genuine gingers were worked before and after extraction with cold water, and ash determined.

Method of working for determination of cold water extractive in ground ginger.

Weigh 10 grammes into a 500 cc volumetric flask of Wagner form; fill to the mark with distilled water, close, and place on a rotator of 24 inches diameter revolving 40 times per minute for 30 minutes. Centrifuge a portion of the mixture, filter and evaporate 50 cc to dryness in platinum at 100°C. Cool and weigh residue.

It will be observed that the exhaustion of ginger by cold water results in notable reduction of both the total ash, and the water soluble ash; but the percentage reduction of soluble ash is much greater than that of the total ash.

It follows that an exhausted or spent ginger yields not only a lower extractive, but also a lower soluble ash number.

Before attempting to interpret the numbers obtained on analysis it is desirable to ascertain characteristic numbers for samples known to be genuine.

The first work done in these laboratories upon ground ginger was published in Bulletin No. 48 (May, 1897), and a mean of 14.03 per cent. cold water extractive was found for seven samples of ginger believed to be genuine. The mean soluble ash found for these samples was 2.96.

An improved method of determining cold water extractive was applied to four samples (reported in Bulletin No. 95—p. 23—February, 1904), and resulted in an average of 19.3 per cent extractive. The ash was not determined.

Bulletin No. 137 (July, 1907), gives extractives for twenty-eight samples of ground (mostly Jamaica) gingers, by the method employed in 1904, the average extractive being 21.95 per cent. The ash was not determined.

These results appear to indicate that genuine ginger should yield about 19 to 20 per cent of extractive to cold water, under conditions of working as described in Bulletin No. 95.

Two samples of African ginger, accompanied by guarantees of genuineness have recently been worked in this laboratory, with the following results:—

Sample A—12.80 Extractive

Sample B—14.90 " "

A sample of Jamaica ginger, guaranteed genuine, was worked at the same time and yielded 19.90 per cent extractive.

It follows that a distinction should be made between Jamaica and African gingers in this regard; and it is possible that Cochin, Cape and other varieties of ginger may differ among themselves, characteristically.

Bulletin No. 184 (July, 1909), contains a report on 150 samples of ground ginger. Of this number 112 showed only ginger tissues under the microscope. Ninety-seven of these gave extractive above 14 per cent, and it will be convenient for purposes of study to consider separately, such samples of ground ginger, showing no foreign substance under the microscope, as yielded above and below 14 per cent extractive to cold water.

The subjoined table (1) gives a synopsis of 97 samples of presumably genuine ginger, as reported in July, 1909, (Bulletin No. 184).

If this work done upon 560 samples may be taken as representative of the article, it is apparent that all the better grades of ginger yield above 14 per cent extractive to cold water, and fully 2 per cent of soluble ash.

Further, the best grades of ginger yield much more than 14 per cent extractive, Jamaica ginger apparently yielding 19 to 20 per cent.

It would seem reasonable that this class of gingers should be distinguished in commerce (retail commerce) from the more ordinary varieties; and it is not uncommon to find Jamaica ginger sold as such.

The following Table (IV) gives a conspectus of results obtained with gingers which yielded less than 14 per cent extractive matter.

It is quite evident that Table IV shows a distinctly inferior grade of ginger. In the light of our knowledge that African ginger may yield less than 14 per cent of extractive matter, it would be going too far to conclude that all the samples reported in Table IV are adulterated, or even suspicious; but it is to be remembered that our experience with low grade gingers, vouched for as genuine, is extremely limited. I shall endeavour to secure data in regard to this class of gingers, as soon as possible.

Samples showing less than 10 per cent extractive are, however, so entirely exceptional that it is impossible to regard them as free from admixture of spent ginger. Under this head must be reckoned two samples reported in Bulletin No. 184 and four samples included in the present report. In all these cases the soluble ash is notably less than one per cent.

Adulteration of ginger by admixture of foreign matters is apparently giving place to adulteration by the use of spent ginger. This latter mode of adulteration is much more difficult of detection than the former; and the following statement appears to show that it is replacing the cruder one. The importance of the soluble ash number as a criterion of the genuineness of ginger is suggested by the following synopsis of results obtained with samples showing low percentages of soluble ash:—

With three exceptions it will be seen that a soluble ash of less than 1.25 per cent is accompanied by a suspiciously low percentage of extractive.

The results of the present inspection may be summarized as follows:—

It will be seen from the accompanying report that genuine ground ginger has been sold to our inspectors at prices (retail) varying from 25 to 40 cents per pound. None of even the most grossly adulterated samples are sold at lower prices. This fact tells against the retailer who certainly bought his stock-in-trade at a lower price than he would have paid for high grade goods.

We are often asked to blame the manufacturer rather than the small dealer; but in view of the fact above referred to, there can be no doubt that the retail dealer is thinking of his own profit, and not of furnishing cheaper goods to his customers, when he stocks up with lowest priced wares.

I beg to recommend publication of this report as Bulletin No. 286.
