CONSTITUTION
OF THE
HALIFAX TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION.

ART. I.

The Association shall be called THE HALIFAX TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION.

II.

The primary object of the Association shall be the elevation of the status of Teachers.

III.

For the accomplishment of this object the Association shall employ all legitimate means that may appear likely to prove effective, such as the publication of papers read before the Association by members or correspondents ; public lectures delivered by friends of education ; and application to the Government and Legislature.

IV.

All *bona fide* Teachers—that is, those who are engaged in teaching as their profession within the county of Halifax—

shall be eligible as members of the Association by a majority of votes. Retired Teachers and others interested in the cause of education may in like manner be nominated as honorary members.

V.

In order to defray incidental expenses, every member, on registration of his or her name, and thereafter at the Annual Meeting, shall pay in advance a subscription of one dollar for gentlemen and half-a-dollar for ladies. Non-payment of subscription shall forfeit the right of taking part in the business of the Association.

VI.

The officers of the Association shall consist of a President, Vice-President, a Standing Committee of Five, a Treasurer, and a Secretary, to be elected at the Annual Meeting, and who shall discharge the duties usually devolving on such officials.

VII.

The Association shall meet monthly, excepting June, July, and August, the time of meeting to be determined by the Standing Committee, who shall have power to call a special meeting. The Annual Meeting shall be held in January every year, to which the Standing Committee shall report, and the Treasurer submit the accounts of the Association.

VIII.

The meetings shall be convened by circular to the members and intimation in the newspapers, and shall be presided over by the proper officials. Should these be absent the meeting shall elect a chairman *pro tempore*.

IX.

No resolution shall pass unless notice of the intention to propose it has been given at a previous meeting.

X.

No modification of the constitution shall be made until it has been discussed for at least two successive meetings, and has been finally adopted by a majority of two-thirds of the members present.
