An illustration of this is afforded by the fact that Jerome, after a four years' term, had gripped every artery of municipal government. 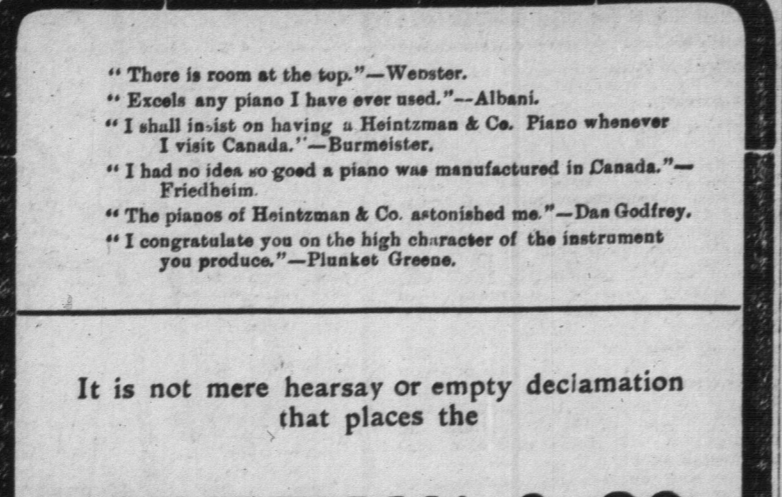

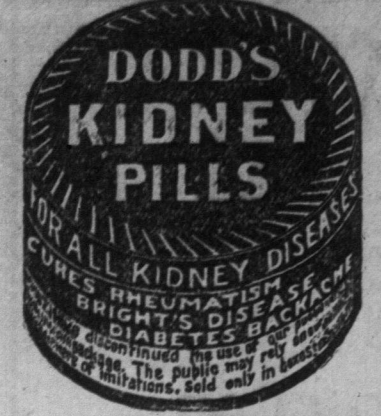
