

FOOTS UP OVER \$800,000. THAT VENEZUELAN MATTER.

ENGINER KEATING'S ESTIMATES OFFICIALLY PRESENTED.

A Comparative Statement Showing Where the Increase and Decrease Occurred. That the Engineer Thinks of the Proposed High-Level Bridge at the Don as a Big Advance in the Waterwork Department.

The meeting of the Board of Works Monday should prove to be of more than usual interest. The estimates of the City Engineer will be presented, and also his report of the proposed high-level bridge at the Don.

In compliance with the request of the committee conveyed to me in a communication dated the 29th January last, forwarding an extract from the inaugural address of His Worship the Mayor, relating to this structure, and a high and low level bridge over the Don River on the line of Queen-street, and also to state which kind of bridge, in my opinion, would be the best to adopt, I beg to state that:

The estimated cost of a high level bridge, as designed by this department some three years ago, which includes financing and all other expenses, but exclusive of land damages, is estimated to cost \$1,000,000. The estimated cost of a low level bridge, that is bridge on trestles, on the same level as the existing bridge, is estimated to cost \$1,000,000, inclusive of financing and all other charges against this work.

In reference to my opinion as to which would be the best bridge to adopt, I may say that on an engineering point of view there can be no question but that the high level bridge would be the best, as it would avoid all risk of accidents by its elevation above the water level, and would give the best accommodation to the public by reason of non-interference to traffic being caused by the use of the railway lines.

In view, however, of the statements contained in the Mayor's message and the desire for economy in the finances, a bridge with a roadway built at approximately the same level as the existing structure is presented as the only one practicable at present under the circumstances.

The estimated difference in cost between the two structures is \$12,000,000 in favor of the low level bridge, to which amount would have to be added the cost of the land which would be required for the high level bridge, and the means of determining which is the best, in my opinion, is in the hands of the Assessment Commission.
