FIRST EDITION. FRATRICIDE. JAMES POLLEY ON TRIAL FOR KILLING HIS BROTHER.

A Respectable Merchant in New Brunswick has written the following account of the trial of James Polley on trial for killing his brother. The trial took place at St. John's, N. B., on the 28th of June. The accused was charged with the murder of his brother, James Polley, on the 28th of May. The trial was held at the Court House, St. John's, N.
