ANNUAL REPORT

The Secretary realizes the embarrassment of his position in offering so imperfect a substitute for the Missionary Report of the year ending June, 1874.

The want of organization has been keenly felt in this department of the Church, as the Mission work was so completely under the management of the auxiliaries that only local interests could be reached. The revised method, and the new Constitution adopted with the provision of Incorporation, and the appointment of a competent Board, as given on another page, will show the design of the Church through the Missionary Society. The Annual Conferences, or their auxiliaries, in conformity to the Discipline, will order the Missionary affairs in their several stations.

The methods of collecting are still with the Presiding Elders and Pastors, and all the affairs of the current year to be concluded by the several Annual Conferences.

The new Constitution, and its provisions, will come into operation at and after the Conferences of next Spring.

A little crudeness will appear in the reports of these several balance sheets by the respective Treasurers ; a brief summary of which is here subjoined for a ready reference :—

Devout acknowledgements and generous gifts are a fitting offering to present for the many blessings attending our feeble efforts in the past, and a stirring of the whole body to a greater activity and liberality in the future of our Missions.

RECENT LEGISLATION.

The following items were adopted by the General Conference to regulate the Mission work for the ensuing four years :—

That the present state of the Mission work of the Church needs to be strengthened and enlarged.

It is therefore recommended that the administration in this department of the Church be changed so as to place the business in the care and management of the Missionary Society.

The Board of Missions shall be competent to appropriate the amounts to be expended by each Annual Conference, and to state the amount expected from each Conference as an annual contribution to the funds. All other appropriations and disbursements to be determined by the Board.

Resolved, That we recommend the election of a Missionary Secretary to raise funds, search out and explore new fields, and arrange for their cultivation ; to visit the Missions of the Church, and in all proper ways to promote their interests.

The collection of funds by the Secretary shall not interfere with the Annual Conferences, which shall continue to regulate the Sunday Schools and Churches, and their officers in collecting moneys ; but in no case shall the Secretary be regarded as a substitute for the officers and pastors of the churches in this work.

CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE I.—This shall be known as the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Canuda, and shall be composed of all persons who shall pay One Dollar annually to its funds.

ART. II.—The Board of Management shall consist of a President, who shall be the officiating Bishop, three Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, a Secretary, and three laymen, who shall be appointed by the General Conference; one Presiding Elder and one Minister, who shall be appointed by each Annual Conference yearly.

ART. III.—The Board shall print and publish the General Report of the Society annually, together with the names of those who have paid One Dollar and upwards.

ART. IV.—Whenever the Board shall determine to establish Missions beyond the bounds of an Annual Conference, it shall pay the expenses of such Mission or Missions, provided the appropriations already made to the Annual Conferences shall not be interfered with.

ART. V.—It shall be the duty of the Secretary to present a Report to each Annual Conference of the state of the funds, and the amount appropriated to the Conference for the ensuing year, and also an estimate of the amount expected for the funds of the Society from the Conference.

ART. VI.—The Board shall meet annually in March,* or a month preceeding the session of the First Annual Conference of the year, the place of meeting being decided by the Board.

ART. VII.—It shall be the duty of each Annual Conference to form, within its bounds, a Conference Missionary Society, which shall appoint its own officers, fix the terms of membership, and otherwise regulate its own administration. But it shall pay all its funds to the Treasurer of the Society, excepting the Niagara Conference, which may retain eighteen per cent. of its actual income to pay its existing Debentures, and as soon as they shall have been fully paid, that Conference shall likewise pay all its funds to the Society.

ART. VIII.—It shall be the duty of every Secretary of a Conference Auxiliary Society to forward annually to the Secretary of the Society a list of all subscribers.

ART. IX.—The Board shall require regular Quarterly communications to be made by each of the Missionaries on the respective Missions to the Secretary of the Society, giving information of the state and prospects of the various Missions in which they are employed.

ART. X.—Every person paying Five Dollars annually shall be entitled to an Annual Report, and any one presenting a donation of Twenty-Five Dollars shall be a life member.

 NIAGARA CONFERENCE.

STANLEY MISSION.

My labors on this mission during the past year have been crowned with reasonable success. Souls have been saved. We have a membership of 81, four churches, and five appointments. Church property has increased \$115. Two Sabbath Schools. This Mission is in an excellent condition.

RONDEAU MISSION.

I have labored on this Mission during the past year with a goodly measure of success. Notwithstanding much opposition, I have succeeded in erecting a church and a parsonage. There are now two churches and a parsonage on the Mission. To God be all the praise. And we hope for a good future for Rondeau Mission.

DUNNVILLE

has one church, neat and comfortable, also a good parsonage. The membership is small, but reliable. Over \$225 have been raised during the year for church purposes. The weekly offering system is in successful operation. There is a good Sabbath School, with an efficient staff of teachers. On the whole, the station stands well compared with former years.

SEAFORTH MISSION.

This Mission is in a prosperous condition. There are two appointments, one in the village of Seaforth, the other ten miles south, in the Township of Tuckersmith, with a good frame church at each place, and a very good parsonage at Seaforth. The Society is in a healthy state, and steadily growing. Seventy-three members are returned, fourteen of whom have been taken in during this year.

HARTFORD MISSION

is prosperous. Members 102. Three churches, one other in course of erection in Hagersville. Five appointments. Two Sabbath Schools. The circuit is nearly free from debt.

ONTARIO CONFERENCE.

MADOC.

We have received twenty into the Society. We report 170 members. There is in subscription \$100, and some of the materials for building a church at Hart's Corners. What is called "hard times" has diminished the finances to a little extent, yet we are thankful and hope in the Lord.

ORONO.

Orono has a membership of 90. It is not really a mission field, receiving about as much from the Mission Fund as it contributes. We have had some prosperity; received 28 into Society during the year, leaving a net increase in membership of 19. A series of removals, year after year, has weakened very much what was once a strong and vigorous circuit. May the Lord send prosperity.

SEYMOUR MISSION.

This Mission embraces parts of the Townships of Percy, Seymour, Belmont, and Dummer. It has 10 appointments, with a membership of 158; several having removed during the past year, whose places have been supplied by others taken into full connexion. During the past two months, 70 have been enrolled as probationers. Owing to the fact of the building of a parsonage, a church, and the partial failure of crops, the financial condition will not appear as favorable as last year, although the people will do, and are doing, all they can for the cause in this direction. Present prospect good. This Mission bids fair to be self-sustaining in a short time, the great drawback being the want of commodious places of worship, this being the case more especially in Campbellford and Blairton.

MINDEN.

While on this mission field we have many things to discourage, we also have great reason to thank God and rejoice that we labor not in vain. Twenty-one have been received into Society as the result of two year's labor. Four have removed and two died. Number now in Society, 72. Our congregations considerably increased, holding steady during all the seasons. The finances have been greatly straightened this year, in consequence of the general financial pressure and failure in the

lumbering interests, which have been severely felt in this district. Our people desire our services, but have been somewhat discouraged by their inability to meet the claims of the Church. They have paid to the College, \$5.90; for Episcopal Fund, \$1.73; Superannuated, \$1.55, Mission, \$32.81; the pastor, \$154.88. We had arranged for the erection of a church on the north section of the work, and secured some subscriptions, but were compelled to lay it over for the present.

QUEENSVILLE.

During the past year this field of labor has received some manifestations of God's presence and blessing, the revival interest has been felt in some of the classes, sinners have been converted to God, and the members, while laboring for God, have been blessed and encouraged to trust in Him. Eighteen have been received into the Church. To God be all the glory. We have suffered greatly by removals. During the year twelve members have left the bounds of this charge, eight have been dropped, and one dear sister has gone to be with Jesus, which is far better. At the Elm Grove Appointment the little flock intend building a meeting house (God willing) in the summer. The land is promised, and several brethren from the other appointments have promised to help. We hope soon to see the work in progress. The Lord bless and prosper Zion.

J. WILKS.

CREEMORE

has enjoyed a good degree of prosperity during the past year. The circuit has been considerably enlarged, one new church built, and other connexional property improved. All claims of the Conference met except the percentage for the College. This is a large field, and requires more laborers and an increased missionary appropriation. Membership, 118; appointments, 10; a full quarterly board. Our interests are enlarging in this important section of the Province.

W. M. POMEROY.

MEAFORD

has been somewhat prosperous during the past year, especially in the town of Meaford. We have a membership on the work of 146. There was raised on the Mission, the last year, for the Missionary Fund, \$121.78. The Church property has been considerably improved. The preachers' salaries have been nearly all paid. On the whole the Mission is improving. However, it still remains to be a hard field of labor, and will, no doubt, require assistance from the Missionary Fund for some years.

MOUNT FOREST MISSION.

Mount Forest, thank God, has enjoyed some prosperity. We had hoped for a large increase in good things in connection with this Mission at first, but our fondest hopes and expectations are not always realized; yet we are thankful to the Great Head of the Church for what we have enjoyed, in common with the people, for this is the sure way of getting more. Our financial claims have been fully met. The Missionary collections amount to \$118. The church in Mount Forest has been improved to the amount of between two and three hundred dollars, including a new organ. The Sabbath School here has been kept up successfully. The Mission has six appointments, and affords sufficient work for two men. The good Lord has revived his work during the year, so that we are enabled to report an increase of upwards of twenty in membership.

EUGENIA.

This Mission embraces a part of Artemesia, Osprey, and Euphrasia Townships, has 70 members, 4 chapels, with property to the value of \$1,500. Ten new subscribers to the *C. C. Advocate* procured during the past year, and other departments of our work increasing in interest. Altogether, this is now a promising field, with an influence steadily widening.

ALEX COOPER.

HANOVER AND WALKERTON

reports as follows: Four churches; one parsonage, worth \$1,750; three Sabbath Schools; there are seven appointments. The work is in a prosperous condition, except Walkerton, where we have had no success during the year.

MELANCTHON.

This Mission has eight appointments, six Sabbath, and two week nights; has a membership of ninety-seven; four Sabbath Schools; two churches, and another under contract. On the whole, this Mission is in a somewhat prosperous condition, and, under the blessing of God, we hope to hear a favorable account in the future.

TEESWATER MISSION.

This Mission embraces parts of the Townships of Kinloss and Culross. There are five appointments. The congregations are good. We have erected a stone church in the village of Teeswater this year, and raised for the Mission Fund \$96.65, and all the other financial claims fully met.

LISTOWELL MISSION.

This field of labor embraces parts of the Townships of Elma, Wallace, and Maryboro, has seven Sabbath appointments; three Sabbath Schools, which are doing a good work. And although we have had one death and fifteen removals during the year, still we are able to return an increase in our membership. We have now a new and comfortable parsonage in Listowell, partly furnished, and other improvements are contemplated immediately after Conference. The *Advocate* has enlarged its circuit. Listowell Mission is advancing, and will soon stand in the list of self-sustaining circuits.

LONSDALE.

This Mission embraces parts of the Townships of Richmond, Tyendinaga, and Camden. There are twelve appointments and two Sabbath Schools. The flourishing village of Millpoint has been added during the year, and a class of twenty members formed. This place demands our attention,—the interest is growing. We have had some improvement in Church property, and a small numerical increase. Present membership, 205.

ARDEN.

This Mission embraces parts of the Townships of Kennebec and Olden. We have 6 appointments, and 193 members. There are five promising Sabbath Schools, most of which have been kept in operation during the year. The people are strongly attached to the Church, and gladly receive our ministrations, but, in many instances, their ability to support is unequal to their will. The land is very rough, and in many cases unproductive. The dependence of the people on the lumbering business for support, renders their means of subsistence uncertain, and when that business fails, as in the past year, they are left without resources. This field demands the services of a strong man, who, if faithful and energetic, will find a reward for his labors in the willing and cheerful reception of his teachings. There is a good church and parsonage in the village of Arden, and another church in course of erection at Mountain Grove.

VERONA.

During the past year this Mission changed in some respects. Last Conference it was separated from Sherbrooke or Parham. Its membership, too, has changed to some extent. Through dropping, removing, and dying, 43 have gone, yet God has been pleased, through our humble toil, to bring into the fold 49, so that we are enabled to report an increase of 6. Present membership, 163. We have succeeded during the past year in finishing the church at Richardson (called Verona formerly), and in the three years of our incumbency here, we have gained in church property \$1,800. Three good Sabbath Schools have been organized and maintained; expenses of the same this year, \$50.75. By the recent discovery of iron ore in great abundance, and other valuable minerals, in the Townships of Bedford and Hinchinbrooke, together with the opening of the Kingston and Pembroke R. R., hopes are entertained that this will be a rich and valuable part of the country. The village of Richardson, named after our venerable Bishop, and where our new church is, is growing with great rapidity. Though promising, it yet needs aid from the Missionary Society. A parsonage is required also. We have three week night and six Sabbath appointments.

R. runs through the centre of this Mission, which will enable us to form a centre near Eagle Creek. Properly attended to, this field will prosper with God's blessing.

WOLFE ISLAND

has five appointments, and two prosperous Sabbath Schools. There are four organized denominations here. Of these, the Roman Catholic is the largest, and designs taking the Island. We have a noble-hearted people, who struggle as few people do for an existence. With all their liberality, an improvement can be effected by improving their system; this, I trust, will be done. The church and parsonage are valued at \$1,100. Some improvement has been made during the year. We are also preparing to build a church at the Eastern end of the Island this summer, and have \$900 subscribed for that purpose. All claims fairly met, and \$90.63 raised for missions. God has also been pleased to save some through our humble instrumentality. To His great name be all the glory.

GANANOQUE AND PITTSBURG.

This work is in a good, healthy condition at most of the appointments, and we are justified in looking forward with much hope for a bright future for this part of our Zion. Increase in membership, 33.

MALLORYTOWN

is a hard, but interesting field. We have seven appointments, some of which are unable to support the Gospel among them. Others are both able and willing to support not only the missionary, but all the institutions of the Church. More missionary money has been raised than appropriated to this place, and we have given attention to every department of our work. God has also owned our labors in the conversion of precious souls.

ENTERPRISE MISSION.

This work, in its present shape, is new, having been separated from the Camden circuit last Conference. The year now closing has been

one of toil and success, with, of course, dark shadows occasionally mingling in the sunshine. There are two principal appointments, and two minor ones ; for all practical purposes only two, Centreville and Enterprise. At the former place, our church this year has been entirely remodeled ; having spent over \$500 on it, it is now really nice. The only point of grievance is the site—it is a mile *out* of the village instead of *in* it. At Enterprise we have enlarged our church property, and built a splendid shed 80 ft. long, which is a great boon both to man and beast ; to the former, conveying ease of mind during the service ; to the latter, comfort of body. In both these places, I am happy to say, that grim bugbear called *Debt* has no existence. Our Connexional claims are all met, showing, in some cases, an increase of over two hundred per cent. The P. E. rejoices in a balance at the Bankers, whilst our Missionary returns are much improved. The only deficit on the Mission is found in the Pastorate Fund. This, however, is easily explained when we remember that even in the nineteenth century, there are some who beautifully exemplify *Æsop's* glorious old fable of the "dog in the manger of hay." With these very few exceptions, the pastor wishes to record his high estimation of the uniform kindness and attention of the friends on the Enterprise Mission. Our Sunday School at Enterprise, using the Berean Series, Leaf Cluster, &c., has been prosecuted vigorously during the year, with no winter sleep. We have received into the Church this year, 20 ; present number of members, 103.

HUNTLY AND BELL'S CORNERS.

This Mission continues to enjoy financial prosperity. During the year we built a shed by the church in Huntly, and paid a debt of \$110 remaining on the parsonage in Nepean. Also secured two lots, and have two churches in course of erection, each being enclosed and roofed. All claims are met. We have a liberal people and a growing interest.

ROBERT SHORTS.

ARNPRIOR.

This Mission is an interesting field of labor. We have a church and parsonage at Arnprior, and a fine lot for a church at Sandpoint. Membership increased by 70, and \$95.70 raised for Missions. This will soon be one of our best circuits.

NEWINGTON.

This Mission embraces portions of Osnabruck, Finch, and Cornwall. There are seven appointments, four classes, two chapels, a parsonage, and a membership of 149. Over \$3,000 raised this year for Church purposes; one chapel completed, worth \$1,000; one acre of land secured in the third concession of Finch for a chapel and burying-ground, and \$600 for the church; one acre secured in the village of Burwick for a burying-ground, and two acres for a church site, also upwards of \$400 subscription for the church. This Mission is in a healthy state, temporally and spiritually.




