Farm and Household.

Family Matters.

The flavor of common molasses is much improved by boiling and skimming before using.

Clean brass kettles before using with salt and vinegar, to avoid being poisoned by the verdigris.

Gum tragacanth dissolved in water makes a good and cheap paste which will keep when it is sealed up.

Damp tea leaves scattered over the carpet before sweeping, improve the colors and give them a fresh clean look.

A strip of thick paper laid over the edge of each stair under the carpet will preserve a stair carpet from wearing through one-third longer than otherwise.

A palatable drink for a fever patient is made by peeling and slicing some good tart apples, and mixing some white sugar over them. When cool pour off the water and drink.

To destroy insects, take carbolic acid diluted with water, say one part of acid to ten parts of water, and with a syringe throw this liquid into all the cracks and holes where they nest, and they will soon vanish.

When you want a dust pan, have it made to order, with the handle turning down instead of up, so as to rest on the floor, and tip the pan at a proper angle for receiving the dust. It is a great convenience, as you do not have to stoop and hold it while you are sweeping.

Collect some soot from a chimney or a stove where wood is used as fuel, put it in to an old pitcher and use it to water your plants every few days. The effect upon plants is wonderful in producing a rapid growth of thick shoots and a great number of thick, richly tinted leaves.

A little bowl of sage jelly can be made by mixing two tablespoonfuls of sage in one pint of water, sugar enough to sweeten sufficiently, the juice and a little of the grated peel of one lemon. Let it stand for half an hour, so the sage will soften; then boil until it is clear. It will need careful attention and constant stirring to keep it from burning.

Sliced sweet potato pie will be a new and welcome dish to some cooks. Steam the potatoes tender, not soft; then cut in thin slices and mix with an upper crust for the pie; season with ginger and spice the same as you do a squash pie. If you prefer, you may mash the potato and cook with milk and eggs, and then you will have a mock squash pie.

A writer in a German paper states that it is a custom in offices in that country to have a sliced potato on the desk in commercial houses. He does not state whether the custom should be law or not, but the probability is that it is foolish. The use of the potato is to clean the pen and generally acts as a pen-wiper. It removes all ink and crust and gives a peculiarly smooth flow to the ink. He also states that the Hamburg clerks pass new pens two or three times through a gas flame, and then the ink will flow freely.

Irish Affairs.

LONDON, May 25.

A letter from Dublin to the *Morning Post*, dated May 24, contains a violent denunciation of the London and the London press, and demands that the London press should be held responsible for the death of the late Mr. Parnell.

The *Times* says it can be doubted that the speech of Dillon in the Commons yesterday was intended to prove to his disaffected countrymen that he is no party to the Kilmainham compact. The *Standard* says: "Most of the Irish members declare that Dillon's speech in the Commons yesterday was inopportune. Several liberals who had intended to sign a memorial to Gladstone asking for a modification of the more stringent clauses of the repression bill now decline to sign it in consequence."

BUFFALO, N. Y., May 15.—The Buffalo bicycle is a decided novelty in Buffalo. It will be introduced here this season. The bicycle is a screw propeller worked by the wheel exactly as the land machine. The float is in the style of a catamaran, each foot being 22 inches long and 7 inches wide. These have air-tight compartments, and are perfectly safe, so much that an experienced rider has no trouble or danger even in the roughest sea. The speed will be from eight to ten miles an hour. A sailing overboard can be utilized as a sail when the wind is favourable.

Caught in the Ice.

QUEBEC, May 24.

Six sailing ships arrived yesterday. The "George Gilroy" of Greenock, was 20 days in ice; the captain reports that the iceberg was the largest he ever saw, 300 or 350 feet in height and one to two miles long. When off Cape Aquilla he noticed a ship of 1000 tons burden ashore with masts all gone. The crew could be seen on the shore walking up and down with their hats and coats spread on the ground as if to dry, but owing to the large quantity of ice in the neighborhood, it was found impossible to approach the shore. He passed about fifty sailing vessels and three steamers.

Is the duty added to the price? The *Hamilton Spectator*. And it replies to its own question:—"In order to test that question, a gentleman living in Boston imported a pair of English blankets. The English price was \$4.45, and duties and custom house fees amounted to \$4.90, or more than 100 per cent., bringing the total, without charging anything for freight or handling, to \$9.35. If the duty were added to the price, that would be the selling price of like blankets of home manufacture. But like blankets of home manufacture were selling at \$5.20, or 75 cents above the English price, as low as the English blankets could possibly be sold if there were no duty. The like demonstration has been made in Canada, where the duty on blankets has largely increased and the price has largely decreased though in the mean time the price of wool has advanced. The Opposition seek to distract the minds of wool-growers in Canada by pointing out that some grades of wool are admitted free of duty. What are the facts? We import more wool than ever. In 1877-8 we imported 6,230,084 pounds; in 1880-1, 8,040,287 pounds. If that were all, as the Opposition pretend, there would be some show in their attacks upon the tariff in regard to wool. But it is, in fact, only half the story. Turn to the other side, and from the export returns it will be found that, while in 1877-8 we exported 2,445,893 pounds, in 1880-1 we only exported 1,404,123 pounds. That simply means that because of the manufacture of woollen goods developed under the tariff a home market was found for 1,041,770 pounds of home-grown wool that would otherwise have been sent out of the country. There was in addition an appreciable rise in the value of the export, averaging in 1881-2 30 cents per pound, against 28 cents in 1878. The less sent out, the more the price received for what was sent.
