THE OSCAR WILDE CASE
MORE EVIDENCE ADDUCED BY THE PROSECUTION.

Young Parker Made to Appear in a Bad Light - Witnesses of All Kinds Take the Stand - Hearing Adjourned for a Week.

London, April 11.—Great crowds of people gathered outside and inside of the Bow street police court this morning when Oscar Wilde and Alfred Taylor were brought from the prison in the black marks in order to be examined on the charge of having committed serious misdemeanors. The court opened at 11 o'clock with both prisoners in the dock. Wilde looked haggard and worn and was much subdued, although he smiled once or twice when certain questions were put to him, he seemed to realize the gravity of the case.

He was dressed as fashionably as ever, carrying a shining silk hat in his hand and displaying one of the well-known fingers many sparkling diamonds. Taylor was dressed in a more modest manner, and was evidently not so deeply impressed with the proceedings as was his companion in the prisoner's dock. Sir Edward Clarke, who acted as the general agent for Wilde and Alfred Taylor, served cross-examination of the witnesses until five o'clock. He then acted for Taylor. The prisoners are evidently making a lawyer said he would recall all the witnesses who were examined on Saturday last, as Taylor was not represented by counsel upon that occasion. Charles Taylor, one of the witnesses, was examined in the witness box this morning. He was subjected to examination by Sir Edward Clarke, but his testimony was not shaken. The admission was wrung from him of his offences with other gentlemen besides Wilde. Parker admitted that he had received £20 by extortion from gentlemen. The proceedings were continued until five o'clock, when the court adjourned until Saturday next.

CLEVER SWINDLERS.
Counterfeiters Operate in Bogus Postage Stamps.
Hamilton, Ont., April 11.—The Canadian Novelty Co., which has an office in this city, is alleged to be counterfeiting United States stamps. The following particulars have been obtained: On the 1st of March, a man giving his name as George Morrison and who said he was engaged in buying and selling bankrupt stocks, visited the desk in the store of Arthur B. Mack, a painter, at King William street. Morrison installed in his office as his secretary a woman named Mrs. Mack, recently of East 3rd street, New York. The woman was given instructions and then Morrison departed, ostensibly for the purpose of opening an office in Toronto. Following Morrison's departure, Mrs. Mack wrote out an advertisement which was inserted in Printer's Ink, a Toronto paper. The advertisement was to sell \$15 worth of two cent stamps for \$10. The advertisement was identical with the one which appeared in the Chicago Tribune, and which both Morrison and Mrs. Mack were given several carefully read copies of. The advertisement was not what the packages contained. A few days later Morrison wrote a letter from Morrison from Buffalo instructing her to forward certain parcels to different addresses in Chicago, which she complied with the request. Later on Mrs. Mack received an advertisement from Morrison saying that one of his agents would call on her and receive all money belonging to the firm. Morrison's agent would identify himself by asking for Morrison. The man has not called. It is certain that the Hamilton branch of the concern has not been more than a few days, and Mrs. Mack, who is in the employ of Morrison, is a married woman. Nothing about the premises to suggest a probability that the stamps were manufactured there, although several two cent stamps were found lying about in a pigeon hole. Mrs. Mack said she did not know whether they were genuine or not. Morrison has apparently no connection with the concern other than being in the employ of Morrison. While a reporter was conversing with Mrs. Mack, a telegram message arrived with a telegram addressed to the Canadian Novelty and Supply Co., Mrs. Mack received the message and paid 5 cents charge. She then immediately wrote a letter in an envelope and went out to mail it, presumably to Morrison. Mr. Mack described Morrison as a man about 30 years of age, rather tall, with dark curly hair, dark eyes, a smooth shaven face, and a well-dressed man. He had been in the employ of Morrison for some time, but he was certain that the concern had not been more than a few days. Morrison, Police Inspector McMahon interviewed Mrs. Mack, but could learn no new facts in relation to the concern, or the concern, or to the whereabouts of Morrison.
