Bill for a Bankruptcy Law

The order of the day for the House in Committee on the petition presented on Wednesday last, for the passing of a Bankruptcy Law, being read, the House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee, Mr. J. Van der Meer in the chair.

Mr. VAN DER MEER said that the necessity of a Bankruptcy Law was admitted in all mercantile communities. It was adopted by a few, who said that it opened the door to fraud. Perhaps a few might think that it was a law that was not wanted, but a number of those who did business between 1837 and 1859 were in this position, and when they commenced manufacturing goods, their creditors came along and swept the goods of their shelves, so that they were unable to support their families.

Mr. COLES did not intend to say anything as yet, as he had expressed his sentiments on this subject on a former occasion. The House should be very careful in regard to passing a Bankruptcy Law; a debtor, going into a Bankruptcy Court, should be treated as a man of straw, and not as a man of flesh and blood.
