MASSACRES IN NEW GUINEA.

VILLAGE BURNED AND SCORES OF PEOPLE KILLED.

The Deposed Sultan of Viti Making English Trouble in East Africa—Residence in a Quarters Conditioned—Toulon Senation—Continued Frost and Severe Weather in England.

BRISBANE, Australia, Jan. 9.—Advice from New Guinea says the Tugores, the head hunting tribe of the island, attacked a village and during the raid, massacred 40 inhabitants and looted a large number of residences. The tribe threatened to attack some villages near the government post, held under command of Magistrate Cameron, who has charge of the western district. A force of armed constables has been sent to the assistance of Cameron, who has received orders to act on the defensive.

BERLIN, Jan. 9.—The Berliner Tagblatt has received information from East Africa that the natives of Lamu have risen against the settlers, having been incited by Bahrari, the deposed Sultan of Viti. The British Consul has asked the Sultan of Zanzibar to send troops to the scene, as the position of the English inhabitants is very critical.

FIVE YEARS FOR THE MAYOR.

End of the Sensational Toulon Case with Verdict of Guilty.

PARIS, Jan. 9.—At Dragouin today at the trial of Ex-Mayor Dragouin of Toulon for conspiracy to commit a crime, the jury returned a verdict of guilty. The defendant was sentenced to five years imprisonment. The case had attracted much attention because of the sensational nature of the charges against the former mayor.
