THE OLD WORLD'S NEWS.

THE LATEST NEWS OF THE IRISH REVOLUTION BY CABLE.

The Duke of Richmond's Proposal. The Duke of Richmond has proposed to visit Ireland. General News and Notes.

DUBLIN, Nov. 26.—Phillips, arrested under the coercion act, recently fainted in the streets, and the papers in his pocket were abstracted. It is believed the papers were forwarded to the castle officials. Although not a member of the league, it is stated that Phillips has acted as paymaster since Kennedy's arrest.

A writ of habeas corpus has been issued in the court of Queen's Bench at London, in favour of the late Earl of Shaftesbury, who was arrested on a charge of conspiracy.

The proceedings at the forthcoming assizes is anticipated with extraordinary interest. It is expected that the crown counsel have been instructed to put forward early all cases of agrarian crime in which evidence is perfectly clear, and in the event of acquittal or disagreement, to reserve the right to apply for the adjournment of the assizes pending legislation, which would take the form of the appointment of a tribunal consisting of the chairman of the quarter sessions and three stipendiary magistrates, with full powers to try summarily all offences except murder.

CORK, Nov. 26.—The amount lodged in the savings bank here during the present year is the largest since the year 1874.

PARIS, Nov. 26.—It is stated that the committee of the land league has determined to meet the labourers in the town of Limerick, in the county of Tipperary, on the 29th inst.

NEW YORK, Nov. 26.—A hundred and twenty-five delegates of the League of Peace and Brotherhood have left for Chicago to-morrow night to attend the national convention. They include O'Donovan Rossa, Thos. F. Meagher, Assembliesman Haggerty and Senator Fitzgerald.

LONDON, Nov. 26.—Lord Hartington, addressing his constituents at Blackburn to-night, referring to the Irish question, said it was one of almost anxiety, and calculated to inspire the greatest disappointment and dissatisfaction, both as regards the rights of property and preservation of order. Despite the severe counter-measures, outbursts of agrarian crime were still frequent, and the decisions were subject to revision, and the law was being applied before the courts a great reduction of rents before probably be continued. Compensation to the landlords would be considered by the parliament, and the unwavering firmness to act with unswerving firmness.

Sir Wm. Verelst, speaking at Derby, declared the ministry would not serve a single hairbreadth from the path of the law, and that in the kingdom, whether they gained or lost the Irish vote.

ARREBES, Scotland, Nov. 26.—The Duke of Richmond has decided to introduce his large Scotch estates changes commencing on the 1st inst. The changes are in part woodland, and partly improvements, on the understanding that two years' notice of removal will be given by the duke.

NEW YORK, Nov. 27.—The World's London cable says the increase of agrarian crime in Ireland causes great anxiety to the British government, and that the British government are prepared to approve of more and more radical measures which the struggle for land reform has now degenerated.

Considerable excitement exists among evangelists and non-conformists over the proposed amendments to the constitution, which the premier intends to establish close relations with the various religious bodies. The pope had considerable to do with the suppression of the land league, and it is not improbable that the pope's influence is being used in which societies will be reorganized and the faithful exhorted to abstain from political action.

The central organization of the united Irish people, which was formed in New York, has been dissolved, and the members have been directed to express approval of the gift of the land to the people.

PARIS, Nov. 26.—In the chamber of deputies to-day, Brisson read a decree with regard to the land league, and the government's proposals were generally approved.

LATER.—The decree relative to the inspection of imported salt meats provides the freedom of importation, but it will only become operative after the government has renewed for a year the prohibition of the importation of pork from the United States and several European countries.

European strife.

PARIS, Nov. 26.—The French have entirely destroyed the village of Ghabra, in the north of Algeria, and the Arabs have plundered the village and burned some large crops of grain belonging to English merchants.

PARIS, Nov. 26.—A telegram from Madrid states that the hostilities commenced between the Austrians and Kriwovians, who refuse to enter the Austrian military service. The Kriwovians have taken three small forts, making prisoners of the garrison. The report that the Kriwovians took three forts from the Austrians is officially denied.

Restoring Gibraltar.

MADRID, Nov. 26.—In the senate to-day, Gullery, a Cuban senator, asked the government whether it was disposed to land a large force in England for the restoration of Gibraltar. The minister of foreign affairs replied the government would act in accordance with the best interests of the country, and the maintenance of good relations with friendly powers. Replying to another question, he said that Gibraltar was a point in Africa, and not a part of Europe.

IN A ROCKING CHAIR. St. Paul spoke of the christian life again and again as a fight, a combat, a struggle.

SEEDS OF THE MOST ARMINABLE EVILS in our hearts. We can only fight them. Selfishness, pride, malice, lust—all were there. There was no meaning in the prayer "Search me and try my heart."
