This island is fertile, well timbered, finely diversified by intersecting mountain ranges and small prairies, with extensive coal fields, compared by one witness to the West Riding of Yorkshire coal, and fortunate in its harbors. Esquimault Harbor, on which Victoria is situated, is equal to San Francisco. The salmon and other fisheries are excellent; but this advantage is shared by every stream and inlet of the adjacent coast.—The climate is frequently compared with England, except that it is even warmer—The winter is stomy, with heavy rains in November and December; frosts occur in the lowlands in January, but seldom interrupt agriculture; vegetation starts in February, rapidly progressing in March, and fostered by alternate warm showers and sunshine in April and May—while intense heat and drought are often experienced during June, July and August. As already remarked, the island has an area of 16,200 square miles, and is as large, as Vermont and New Hampshire.
