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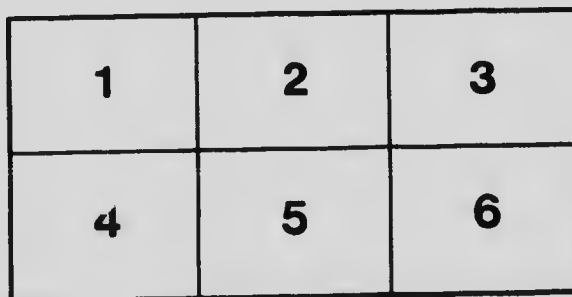
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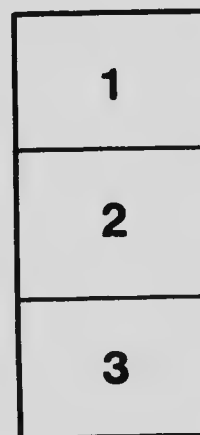
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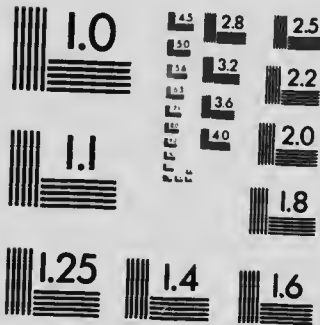

Gates of St. John, I long for you!

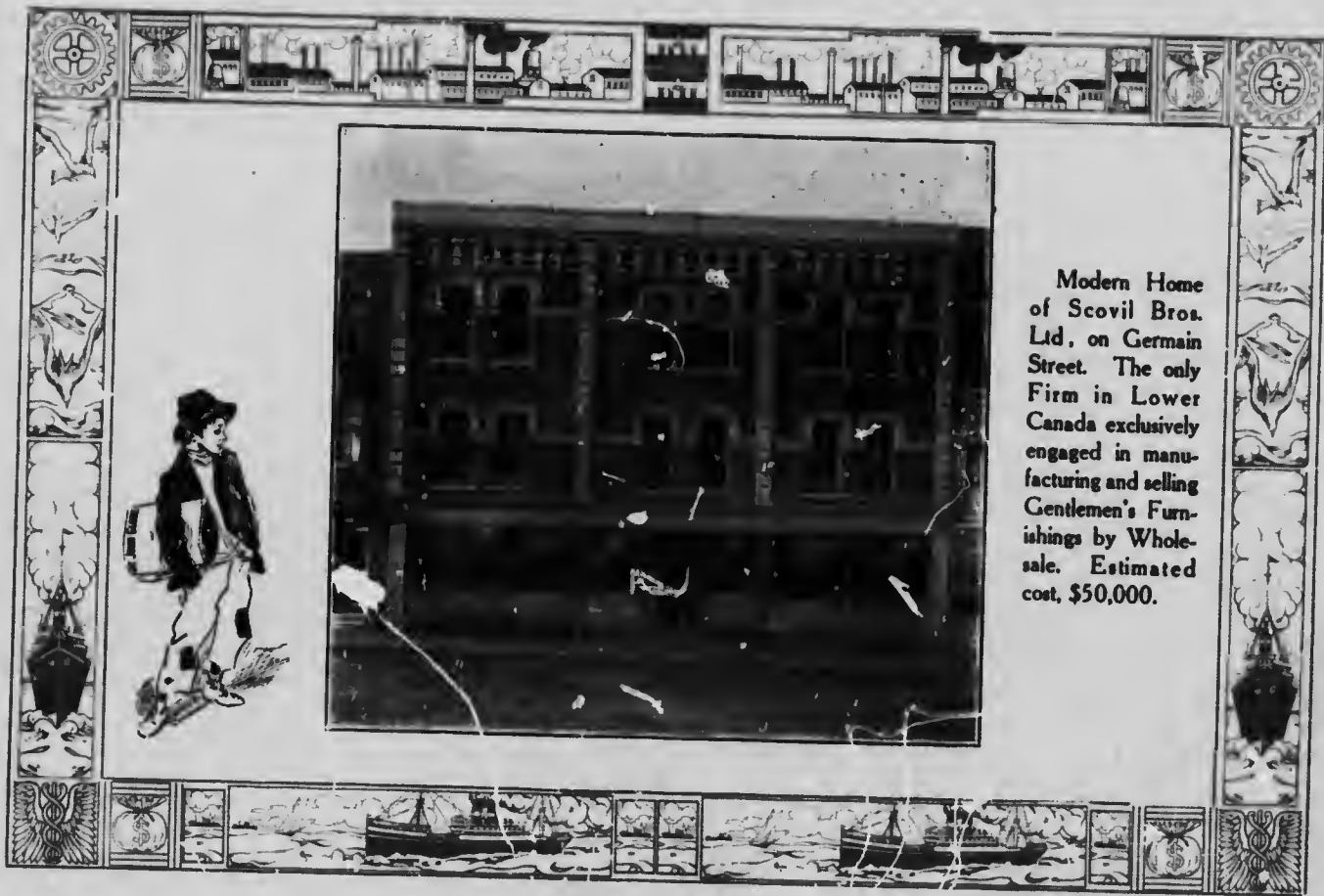
Gates of St. John where the thunders crash

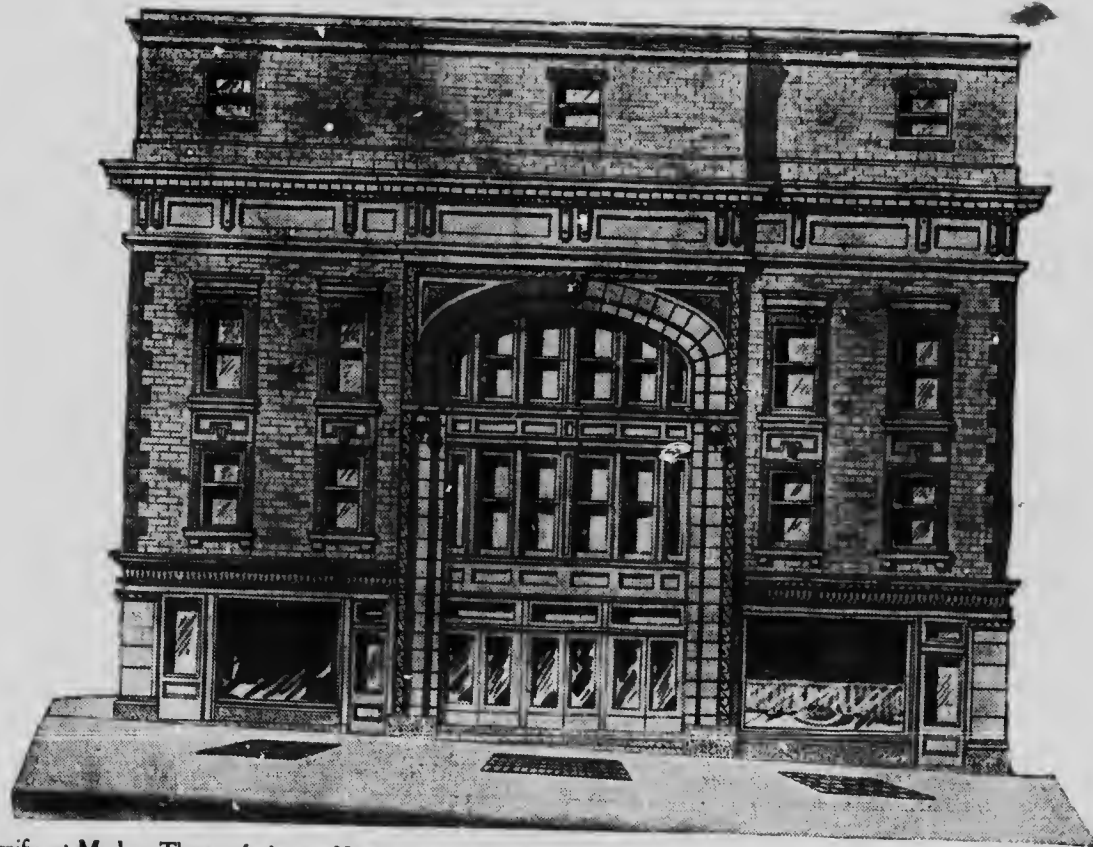

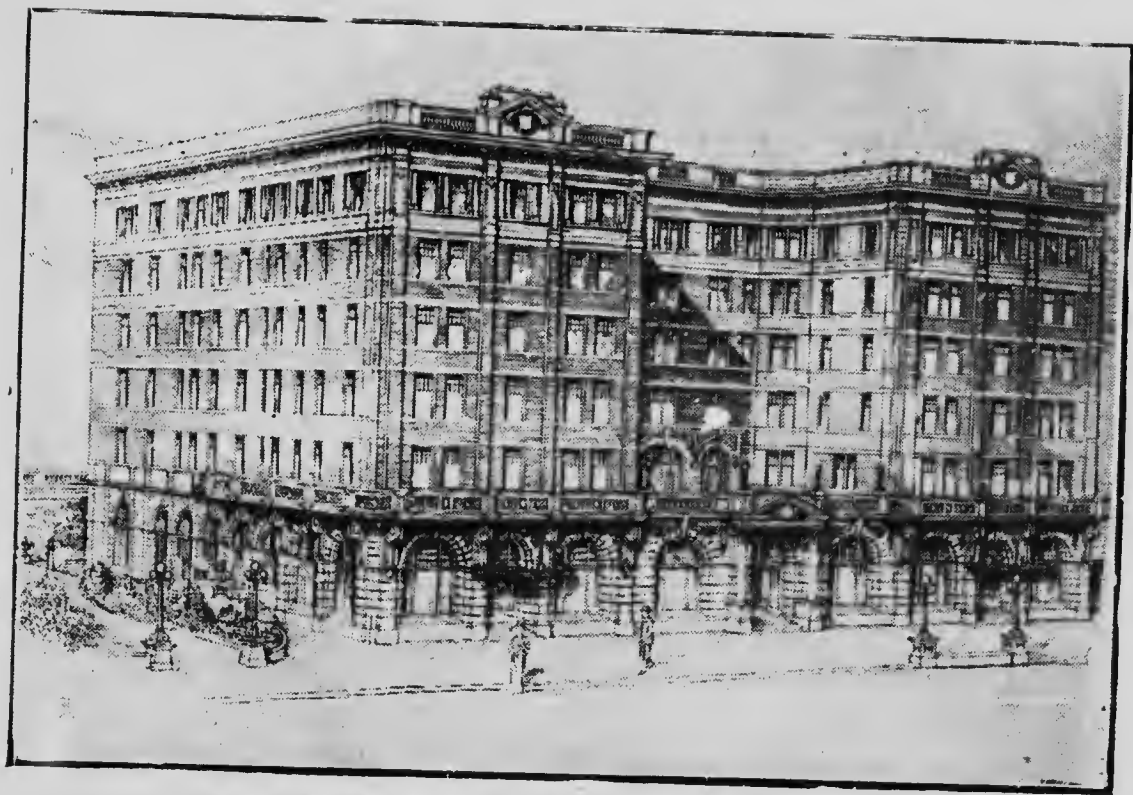

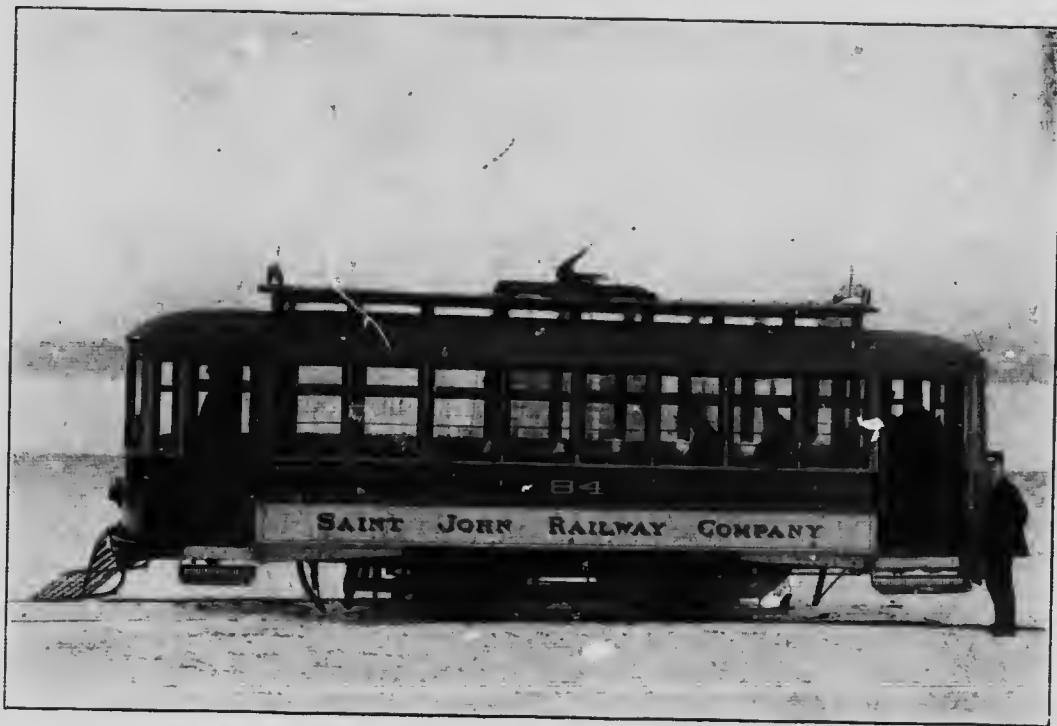

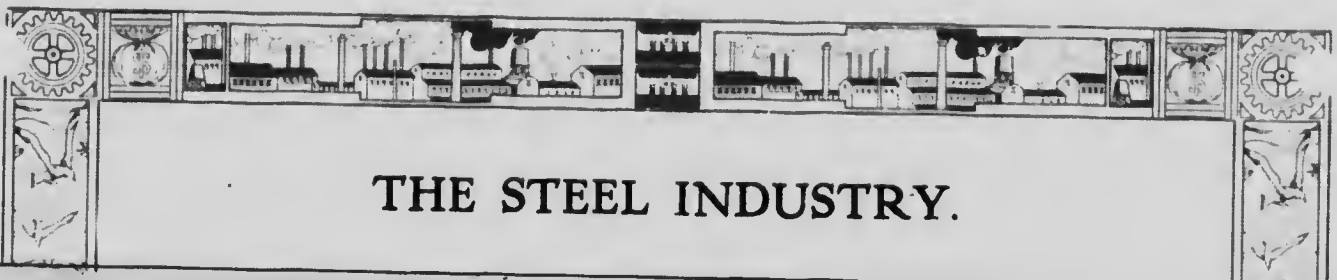

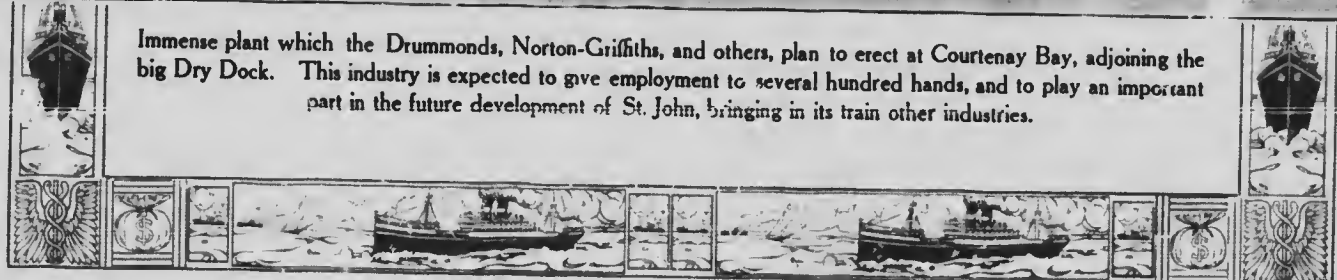

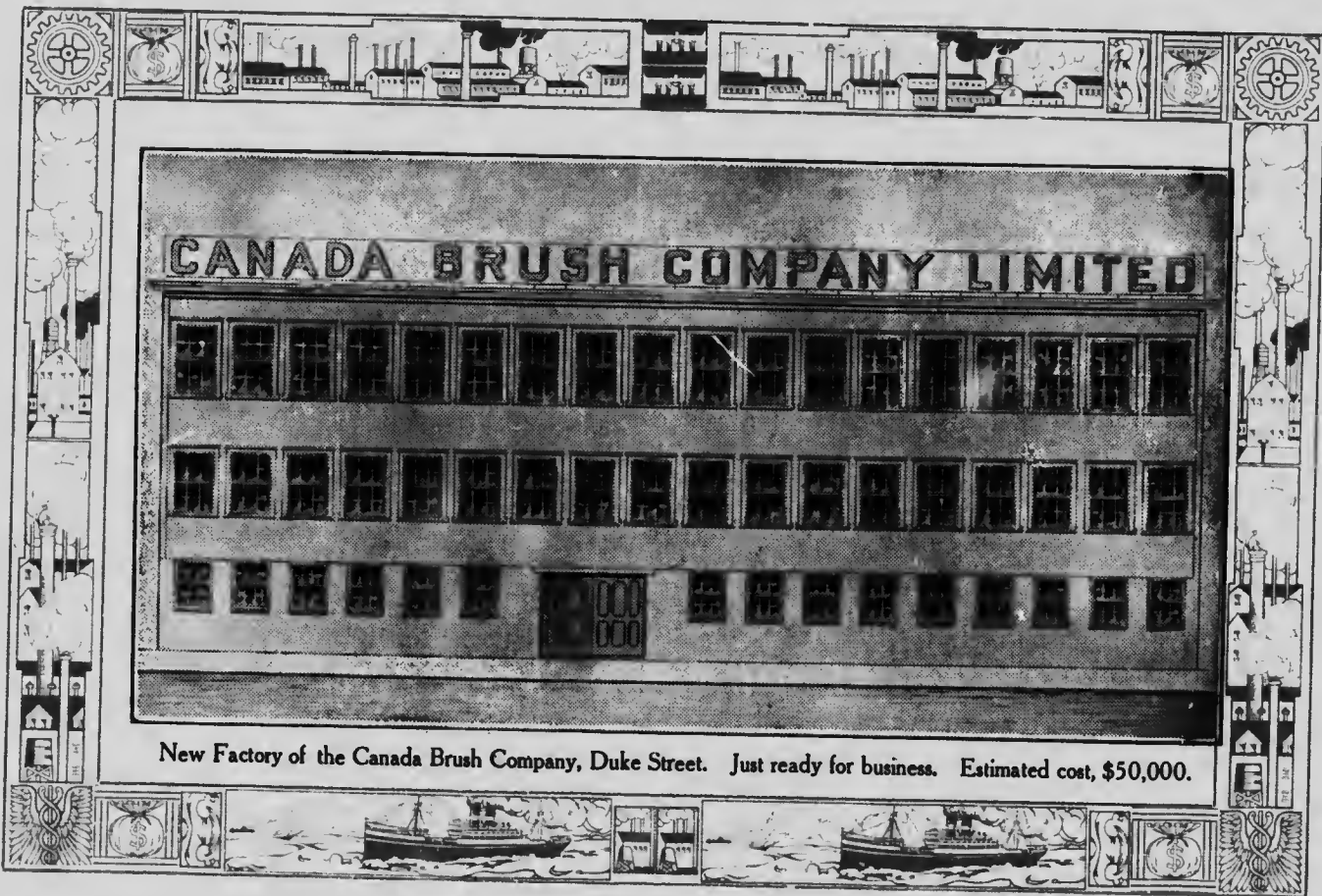

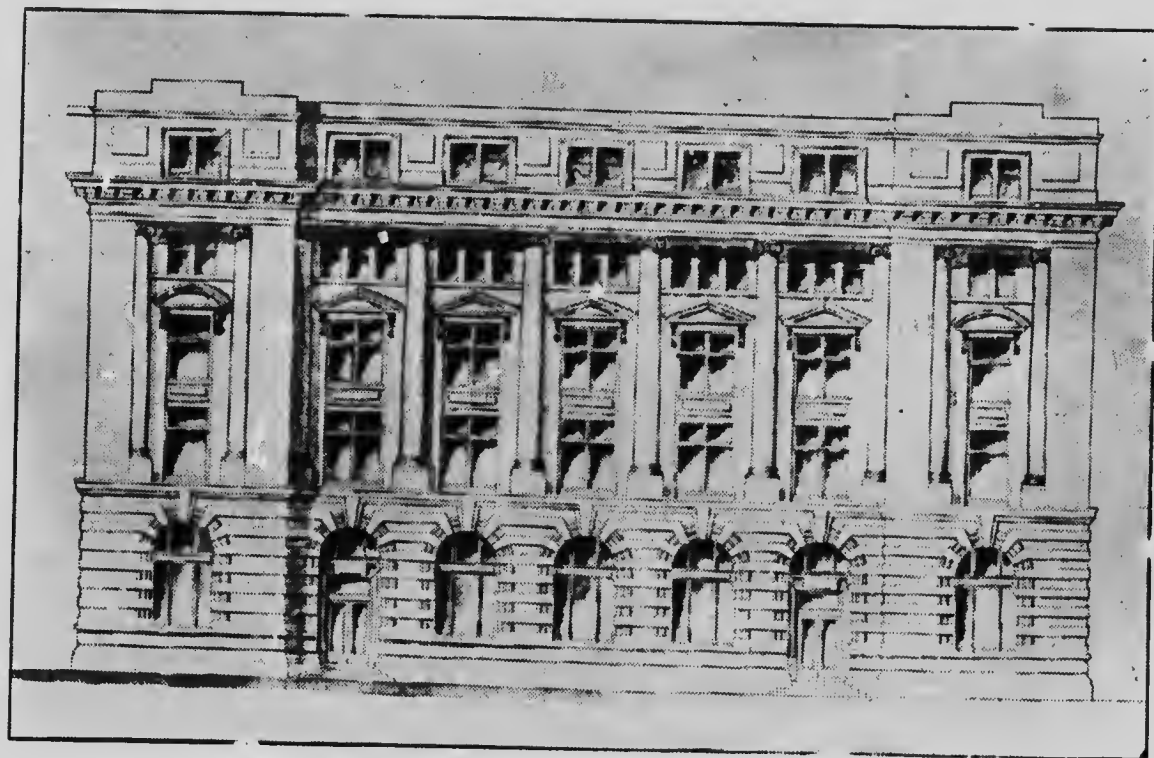


New Brush Factory, the largest in Canada, just completed by Messrs. T. S. Simms & Co.
