Ontruary.—Under the usual heading will be found the announcement of the death of one of Clinton's oldest inhabitants lease Rattenbury. Deceased was born in the parish of Marton, Devonshire, Eng., in 1804, where he resided till 1832, when he emigrated to Canada and settled on a farm in the township of Toronto, remaining there only two years, and then removed to Goderich and opened an hotel, but that occupation does not appear to have engaged all his attention; for he was some time an active member of the Council of that town, and he was the first contractor for carrying the mail between London and Goderich, at a time when frequently one and two letters constituted the whole mail, and four days were allowed for the round trip, though often five days were taken in consequence of the bad state of the roads. About 20 years ago, he came to Clinton, where he had a farm which was becoming very valuable, as it was nearly all included in the town plot, and some portion of it had been leased for building purposes at a high figure. At the time of his death he was the senior magistrate in the County. Although marriad, he leaves no issue, and, therefore, no doubt, his large property will be divided among his relatives which are numerous, as he has two brothers—William and John, and one sister—Mrs. Walters,—New Erg.


