SIXTIETH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE
ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY
OF TORONTO,
FOR THE YEAR 1894.

The recurrence of the season imposes upon the Committee the pleasing duty of presenting this, their Annual Report.

The year that has just passed has been very remarkable for the number of young, single, able-bodied men seeking relief: very many of them being new arrivals who had been sent out by charitable institutions in England. Generally speaking, these men were of good character and respectability, but, owing to the great depression in the labour market, it was with great difficulty employment was found for them; and, in fact, in many instances, in their search for work, they had to be left entirely to their own resources.

During the spring and summer months (a period in which, in former years, little relief was sought) the Society responded to many hundreds of applications.

RECEIPTS.

The total receipts from all sources, including the balance of \$196.52 from last year, amount to \$2,807.79. The receipts from the usual sources, such as the church service and annual membership fees, have been about up to the average, notwithstanding the aforesaid great depression, while the collections for the Christmas distribution were considerably above the average. The standing of the Society, financially, is good, being altogether free from debt.

RELIEF.

During the year, 1,127 applicants have been relieved in the usual various ways, and all practicable services rendered by the Society to the applicants.

The sum of \$803.38 was expended in affording this relief. Orders for eight graves for adults and six for children have been granted in our plot in St. James Cemetery, which plot, as stated in last year's report, is now very nearly filled up.

The sad want of employment over the country is a source of great trouble and anxiety, causing so many able-bodied men to flock into the cities and cast themselves upon the charitable societies for relief.

FINANCIAL.

The Treasurer's statement shows that the society is, as on former occasions, on a thoroughly sound substantial

footing, being entirely free from liabilities, and with a fair workable balance on hand.

MEMBERSHIP.

There have been eleven life members and twenty ordinary members elected during the year. The numbers at the present time are: honorary life members, 11; life members, 420; ordinary members, 549; a total membership of 980, being a nominal decrease of 153, which is to be accounted for, as follows: Firstly, your Committee appointed a sub-committee to thoroughly revise the list of membership, and, as a result, only those who had paid up to the last year, or had promised to do so, were allowed to remain on the list; secondly, a considerable number of those who were elected a little over a year ago alleged that they only considered the subscriptions they then gave as a donation for the time being, and not to be repeated each year; and, thirdly, the dulness of the times rendering so many unable to pay, and obliging others to leave the city.

During the year, so far as our knowledge goes, seven life members have died, viz., Mr. W. W. Copp, of the firm of Copp, Clark & Co., a gentleman of long and honorable standing in the commercial community; Mr. W. Hope, for many years a member of the Stock Exchange and one

of the respected auditors of the society ; Mr. T. Harbottle, one of the oldest and best known navigators on the Lakes ; Mr. John Lugsdin, one of a family of highly esteemed members of the society, and of good commercial standing ; Mr. J. T. Shapter, a very old member, who had, for some time past, retired, in comfortable circumstances, from active commercial life ; Mr. Wm. Tucker, a member of many years' standing ; and Mr. J. C. Carpmael, a gentleman of high scientific attainments.

Of the ordinary members seven also have died, viz., Mr. John Ayre, a very warm and enthusiastic member of the Society ; Mr. Thos. Adams, also a good substantial supporter of the Society ; Mr. E. B. Axworthy, who met his death by a very sad accident, and who was a very generous contributor to the Society ; Mr. Thomas Barnett, a very kind and estimable member ; Mr. D. Sole, of very much the same worthy character ; Mr. G. Virtue, a Past President of the Society, always taking a deep interest in its welfare, and of a most amiable disposition ; and Mr. W. H. Lester, holding a responsible position in the Custom House in this city.

Early in the year a Mr. Cooke, on a visit from England, died at the Queen's hotel, and, at the request of his fellow travellers, the President and Officers of the Society interested themselves in the sad event and attended the funeral, for which they were subsequently thanked by the bereaved widow.

ANNIVERSARIES, ENTERTAINMENTS, ETC.

In accordance with the established usage of the Society, the first Anniversary Service was held in St. James

Cathedral, on Sunday afternoon, April 22nd. The Rev. C. J. Boulden preached a very appropriate sermon on the occasion. The musical portion of the service was well rendered. Several other clergymen were present, and assisted in the service. The Sons of England, in goodly numbers, joined us, and, altogether, the Church was well filled. The collection was a good one. The second service was held in the Bond St. Congregational Church, on Sunday evening, Oct. 14th. The Rev. Dr. Sims preached an able and interesting sermon, but there was a very poor attendance of members. The musical portion of the service was good. The collection was small.

SMOKING CONCERT.

On the 1st of March, a very enjoyable smoking concert was held in the Hall, and there was a goodly attendance. It met with such success that the members hope for another like entertainment at an early date.

ANNUAL DINNER.

The annual dinner was again held in the Hall, on Monday, April 23rd, St. George's Day. Over one hundred gentlemen sat down to the dinner, which was followed by some excellent speeches, and all went off most pleasantly.

EXCURSION.

The annual excursion was to the Falls of Niagara by the splendid boats of the Niagara River Line and the Electric Railway, on the 31st of July. It was a beautiful day. There was a good attendance, and it was much enjoyed. It resulted in a net gain to the Society of \$53.80.

CHRISTMAS DISTRIBUTION.

Our usual annual Christmas distribution to the English poor was made on Monday, December 24th. The applicants were received in the Hall, and went down the stairway to the supper room, where they received the supply provided for them.

The collections were, so far as known, the largest ever made, amounting to \$1,112.60. The expenditure amounted to \$890.70. The number of families supplied was 645, comprising 3,502 individuals, being 247 families and 856 individuals less than last year. This reduction is accounted for by the new system that was instituted resulting in greater carefulness in the giving of the tickets. There was greater liberality in the distribution than formerly, more beef than on the previous occasion, and the same number of loaves of bread and pounds of tea and sugar having been distributed.

ASSISTED PASSAGES.

Early in the fall, applications for assisted passages to England and elsewhere became so numerous and pressing that the Committee was obliged to pass the following resolution, which was subsequently ratified by the Society:

"Whereas, owing to prevalent financial depression and stagnation of trade, and the consequent throwing out of employment of many deserving Englishmen, numerous applications have, of late, been made for assisted passages to England;

"And whereas the St. George's Society aims at giving temporary relief to deserving English people, so that they may remain desirable citizens, rather than to assist them back to the Old Country;

"And whereas the funds of the Society will not permit of further grants in the direction mentioned;

"Resolved: That no grants be, in future, made by the Society towards assisting English people to England, or elsewhere, except under the most extreme and trying circumstances, and, even then, only upon an unanimous vote of the Committee."

This resolution, since it came into effect, has operated as a wholesome check, and, upon the whole, has resulted beneficially to the Society.

CONCLUSION.

In conclusion, the retiring Committee feel gratified in the assurance that they leave the Society's affairs to their successors in office in a sound, healthy, good-working condition.
