A NEW POLICY FOR IRELAND
The London Standard, which is the
leading Conservative newspaper of the
United Kingdom, announces that the
government intend to grapple with the
problem of dual ownership in Ireland,
which has been a source of difficulty ever
since tenant right was legislated by the
acts passed by Mr. Gladstone. It would
seem that this programme is a result of
Mr. Goschen's recent visit to Ireland, in
the course of which he acquired a great
deal of information in regard to the
subject in question.
