BILL.

An Act to provide for the alteration of the times and places for holding the Division Courts, in Division Number Six in the District of Bathurst.

WHEREAS from the great distance at which part of Preamble. the Bathurst District, consisting of Division Number Six, is situated from the District Town, and the difficulty of access to it at certain seasons of the year, from the want of roads or other suitable means of communication, great difficulty is experienced in holding the Division Courts in the said District: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, Division No. 6 to be divided into three Districts, and a Court held three times a year in each.

10 That from and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace, in and for the Bathurst District, to divide Division Number Six of the said District into three sections, and that it shall and may be lawful for the Judge

15 of the District to fix and appoint the times and places in such sections, respectively at and in which Division Courts shall be held three times in each year, within each of the said several sections of the said Division Number Six; any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
