

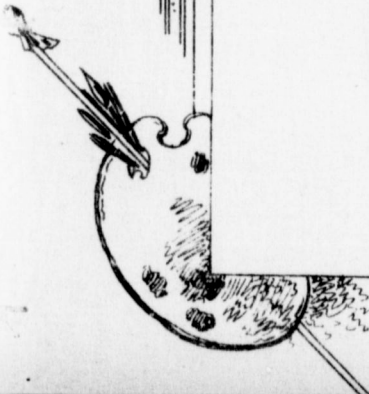

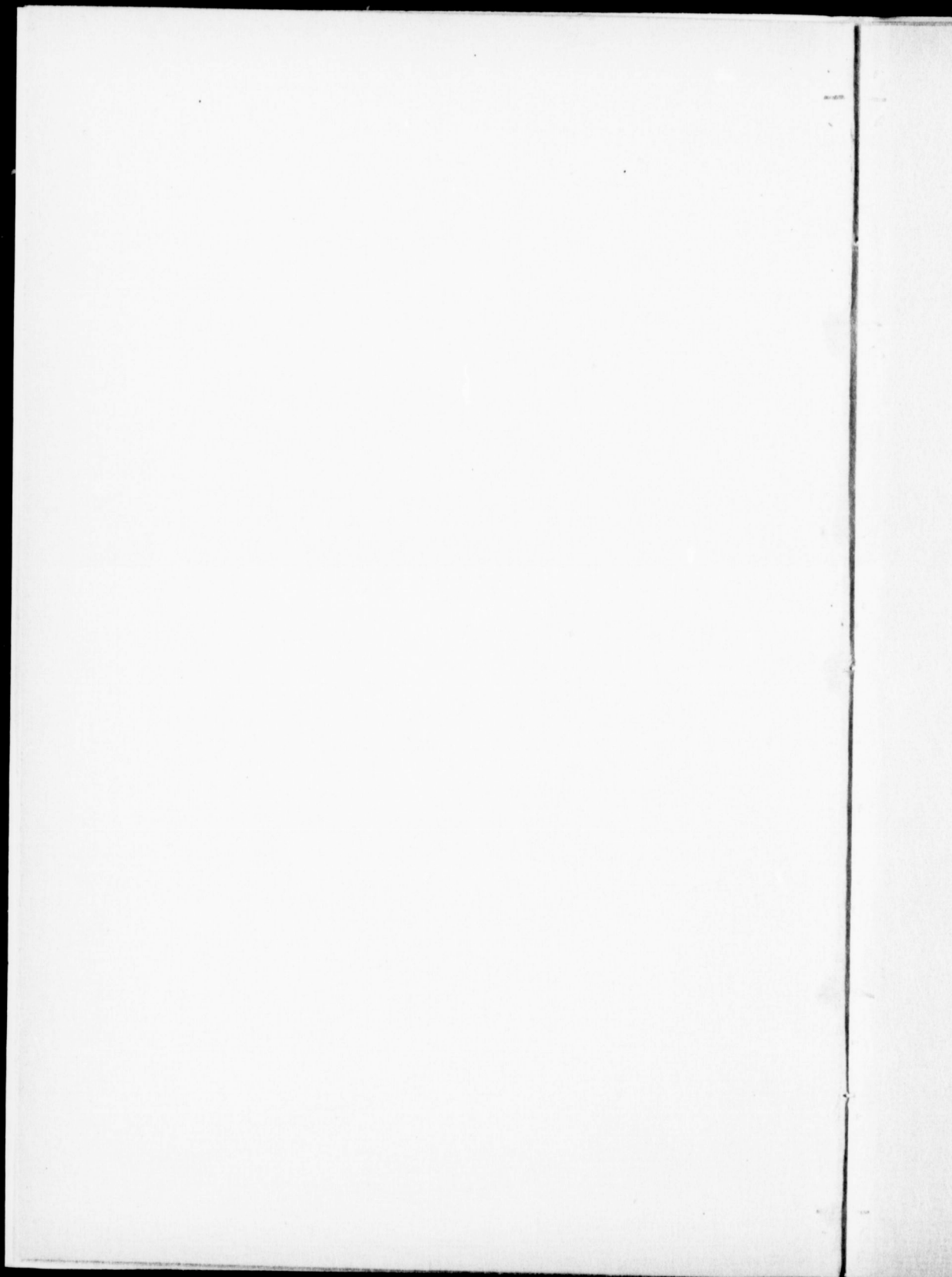

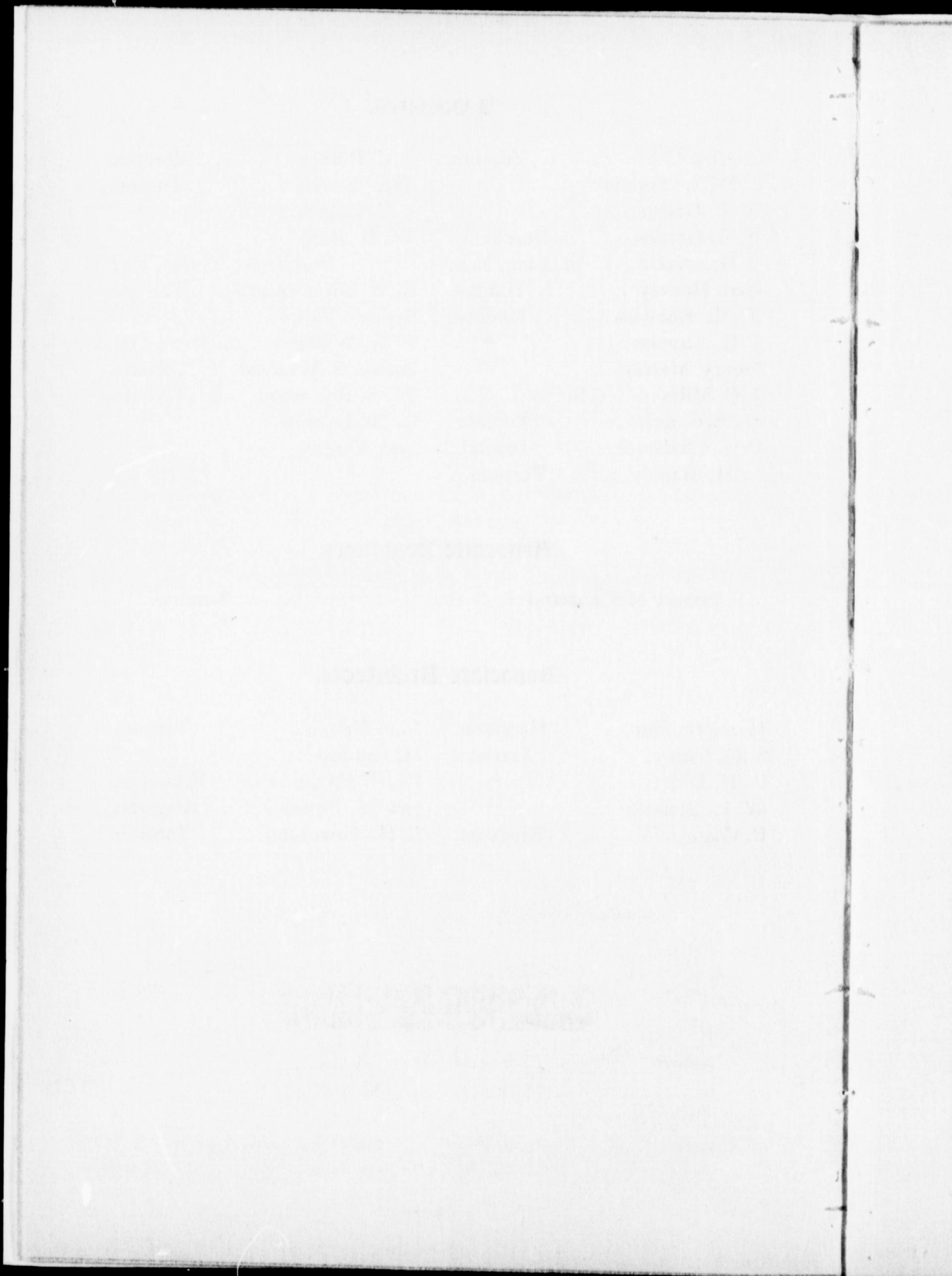

REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

FOR THE YEAR 1891

Another year of work and progress in connection with our Academy has passed, and we are pleased to report that our ranks have not been broken by the death of any member during the past year.

The Annual Meeting and Exhibition was held in the Toronto Art Gallery, when upwards of two hundred and fifty works of Art were exhibited. Unusual care was taken by the Committee of Arrangements to hang only the best works of our members; the result was an Exhibition of great interest, and attended with financial success. Upwards of three thousand persons visited the Gallery; while only a few pictures were sold off the walls, many were disposed of before the close of the year.

The officers elected at the Annual Meeting were the same as the previous year.

Mr. O. R. Jacobi, Toronto, President; Mr. A. C. Hutchison, Montreal, Vice-President; and Mr. Jas. Smith, Toronto, Secretary-Treasurer.

Mr. Henry Langley and Mr. S. G. Curry, Toronto, were appointed Auditors.

The following gentlemen were elected to the rank of Associate Academicians, viz. :—Mr. George Bruenech, Toronto; Mr. F. S. Challenor, Toronto; Mr. W. A. Sherwood, Toronto, and Mr. Carl Ahrens, Toronto.

The following gentlemen were elected to the rank of Associate Academician Architects:—Mr. Joseph Power, Kingston; Mr. W. L. Symons, Toronto, and Mr. S. H. Townsend, Toronto.

The usual grants in aid of the Life Classes in Montreal, Ottawa, and Toronto were made, amounting to four hundred and fifty dollars, and we are pleased to report that the efforts of the Academy in helping these Schools of Art have been deeply appreciated, and ^{their} ~~its~~ hearty thanks have been duly conveyed to the Council for its generous donations.

The accounts for the past year are submitted, showing our receipts, expenditure and balance in hand.

The following important resolution was passed at the last meeting of the Council in connection with the Chicago Exhibition for 1893.

Resolved,—That the Secretary be authorized to communicate with His Excellency the Governor-General, acquainting him with the desire of the Academy to have some representation of Canadian Art at the Chicago Exhibition, and ask him, as Patron of the Academy, to advise as to what steps we should take, and also requesting him to make any representation on our behalf that he may consider most advisable.

The Exhibition of the Academy will be held this year in the National Art Gallery, Ottawa, "the Government having kindly given us the use of it for that purpose," and will be opened on Wednesday evening, the 30th day of March next.
