BRITISH COLUMBIA. THE COAL MINERS' STRIKE AT WELLINGTON.

No Prospect of Surrender on Either Side—Mining on the Coast—The "Nepigon" Disaster.

(SPECIAL TO THE GAZETTE) VICTORIA, Aug. 8.—Both the strikers and employers at Wellington appear to have made up their minds to a policy of no surrender. The usual procedure was held yesterday afternoon in the most orderly manner the officers keeping the road clear. The strikers repeat they will not accept of the miners as strikers but will in no way recognize the union. Large quantities of stores were served out last night to the wives and families of the strikers.

Lyman Banks a representative of eastern capitalists who had 7000 acre of land had imported a complete coal drilling outfit, accompanied by an expert. He leaves tomorrow on the steamer "The Nepigon" and begins preliminary operations.

M. F. Gorrie who has just arrived in this city from Wellington says the reports of damage to the crops in Manitoba are entirely misleading. He says they had not a cyclone, and had only passed over a small corner of Deloraine, whence it swept across the coast. A letter from Beautiful Plains says the crops there were never so fine and the farmers are delighted.

The Lake Nepigon, which ran into and sank the bark Isabel at Quebec, arrived at the mouth of the Saguenay yesterday. The report of the disaster was that the Nepigon lost one of the blades of her screw, but the chief engineer claims that this would make no difference in the vessel's speed across with the blade missing, and that the engine would be repaired in a few days.

The Harbor Commissioners will hold an investigation.
