An Act to make a Verification Survey of the Line between the Fourth and Fifth Concessions of the Townships of Chatham.

WHEREAS G. M. Bradford, John Stephens, John Smith, Henry Hammond, Stuart Boyd, William Boyd and John E. Bealford, the parties interested in a verification survey of the Concession line between the Fourth and Fifth Concessions of the Township of Chatham, in the County of Argenteuil, have petitioned that such verification survey may be made in order to put an end to the difficulty caused by an irregular survey of the said line made by one T. Z. Watson, on the 5th August, 1803, and have prayed that the original survey may be maintained: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

Preamble.

I. The survey of the line between the said Fourth and Fifth Concessions of the said Township, executed on the 27th August, 1798, by Samuel Holland, shall be verified by the Commissioner of Crown Lands and confirmed.

Survey of S. Holland confirmed.

II. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
