BILL.

An Act to provide for the removal of the Registry Office of the County of Terrebonne from the place where it is now kept to a more central position.

WHEREAS the Registry Office of the County of Terrebonne Preamble.
was fixed and is now held in the Village of Terrebonne, in
the said County, and it is expedient for the general convenience of
the population of the said County to change the site of the said
5 Registry Office, and to place it in a more central position; And
whereas the Village of Ste. Thérèse de Blainville is a more central
and convenient place for the majority of the inhabitants of the said
County; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That on the first day of July, in the year one thousand eight hun-
10 dred and fifty-three, the Registry Office for the County of Terrebonne
shall be removed from the place where it is now held, and shall, upon,
from and after the said first day of July, be established and held at
the Village of Ste. Thérèse de Blainville, in the said County.
