

BILL.

An Act to incorporate "The Montreal " Prison Discipline Association."

THEREAS it is desirable that an Asso-Preamble. ciation should be formed in the City of Montreal, for the purpose of visiting and relieving, and improving the condition, moral 5 and physical, of the prisoners confined in the Common Gaol and House of Correction of the District of Montreal, and to report upon the state of the said Gaol and House of Correction, and upon the discipline main-10 tained therein; And whereas the persons hereinaster named have by their petition prayed that for the public advantage they may be permitted to form such an Association, and may be incorporated as such Asso-15 ciation under proper regulations and provisions, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of their petition: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Hon. C. D. Day, J. Smith, Certain per-20 J.McCord, C. Mondelet, M. J. Hays, Hon. J. sons incorpo-Ferrier, D. Davidson, A. Pinsonnault, A. E. Montmarquet, S. Andres, A. A. Papineau. R. Wright, L. Dorval, J. D. Bourdages, J. Boston, W. F. Coffin, and such other per-25 sons as shall under the provisions of this statute become members of the said Association, shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the name of " The Montreal Prison Discipline Associa- Curporate 30 tion," and by that name shall have perpetual name and powers. succession and a common seal, and shall have power from time to time to alter, renew or change such common seal at pleasure, and shall by the same name at all times here-35 after have power to purchase, acquire, hold, possess and enjoy, take, accept and receive

for the use and purposes of the said Corporation, any lands, immovable property or here. ditaments, or any personal property of what nature soever within this Province, not exceeding in yearly value the sum of one thousand pounds currency, and the same to sell. alienate and dispose of, and others in their stead to purchase, acquire and hold for the use and purposes aforesaid; and the said Association may by the said name sue and be 10 sued in all Courts of Law or Equity, or other places whatever, in as large, ample and beneficial a manner as any other body politic or corporate in this Province, and shall have power and authority to make By-laws, Rules 15 and Regulations not being contrary to this Act or to the laws of this Province, for the government and management of the said Association, and of the affairs and property thereof, and for all other purposes relating to 20 the well-being and interests of the said Association, and the same to amend, alter or repeal from time to time in such manner as. they shall deem necessary or expedient.

II. And be it enacted, That the persons 25 hereinbefore mentioned and incorporated, or any five of them, shall as soon as convenient after the passing of this Act, by public advertisement in two of the public newspapers of the City of Montreal, call or cause 30 to be called, a public meeting of the inhabitants of Montreal, at some public place in the said City, for the purpose of forming the said Association, and of opening books for enrolling the names of persons desirous of 35 becoming members of the same, (which said books shall always remain and be in the hands of the Secretary of the Association when that officer shall have been appointed, and in the meantime in the hands of some 40 Member of a Committee to be appointed at the said meeting for the admission of additional members,) and of appointing a Treasurer for the purpose of receiving the subscriptions of persons wishing to become 45

members of the said Association, and of fixing a day and place for the election of the officers thereof, and of doing all other things necessary for the formation of the Associa-5 tion hereby incorporated, and for carrying this Act into operation; Provided always Proviso. that if the meeting or election mentioned in this Section shall not be had on the day first appointed for the same, another meeting may 10 he called in the manner aforesaid and another day fixed thereat for such election, and so onuntil such election shall be had.

III. And be it enacted, That to entitle any what shall person to the rights of membership of this entitle any person to be a 15 Association, or to the right of voting at the member. election of the officers thereof, or of receiving any of the privileges of membership by this Act conferred, it shall be necessary that every such person shall have paid into 20 the hands of the Treasurer of the said Association an annual subscription of not less than two dollars, or any other larger amount of annual subscription which the said Association by its By-laws may hereafter direct 25 to be paid by its members previous to exercising any right, privilege or authority of membership whatever; and the receipts of the Treasurer shall be proof, if proof, is demanded, of the payment of such 30 subscription, and of the right claimed by such member under this Act.

IV. And be it enacted, That the officers officers of the of the said Corporation shall be a President Corporation. Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer 35 and the affairs and business of the said Corporation shall be managed by a Committee Committee of to be composed of five members of the said Management. duly qualified as hereinbefore provided: and the first meeting to be held for the purpose of such election as aforesaid, shall be held on the day and at the place to be appointed as hereinbefore provided, and every following annual general meeting for the same purposes shall be held on a corresponding day of the same month in every following year, (unless said day should be a holyday, and then the next day,) and 10 at such place as the Managing Committee shall notify; and the signature of the President, or in his absence of any member of the Managing Committee whom the said Committee shall appoint, shall be sufficient 15 attestation of all proceedings had, or notices to be issued by the said Association: Provided always, that if any such election shall not be had on the day appointed for the same, the Corporation shall not be 20. dissolved, but such election shall be had onany subsequent day to be notified as aforesaid, and the Managing Committee and officers aforesaid shall continue in office until: others shall be elected in their stead; and 25 the day of annual election may always be changed by any By-law of the Corporation.

V. And be it enacted, That the By-laws of the Corporation shall be made by the said Managing Committee, and being so made, 30 and signed by a majority of the said Committee, and the seal of the Corporation being thereunto affixed, shall be binding on all the Members of the Corporation, and shall be kept open to their Inspection.

Visiting Committees to be appointed.

Their powers and duties.

VI. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the said Association, at such first meeting for the election of officers and at every following annual general meeting, to elect by ballot two Visiting Committees, one to consist of nine ladies, members of the Association, and the other of nine gentlemen, members of the Association, (each of which Committees shall from time to time,

and as any vacancy in the office may occur, appoint its own President, and add to its numbersif desirable,) for the purpose of visiting, severally and respectively, the female and male 5 departments of the Montreal Gaol and the Montreal House of Correction, or any other Gaol or House of Correction now being or hereafter to be in the District of Montreal, and of instructing the prisoners therein, and of re-10 lieving and improving the condition, moral and physical, of the same, which said Committees shall from time to time report to the Managing Committee on the state and discipline of the said Gaol and House of Cor-15 rection, and the said Association shall report annually to the three Houses of the Legislature on the state and discipline of the said Gaol and House of Correction and on all subjects connected therewith; and the said 20 Committees of the said Association and all and every the members of the said Committees shall have free access to the said Gaol and House of Correction at all lawful hours and seasons when visiting is permitted, and 25 under such restrictions always as may be deemed necessary by the officers of said Gaol and House of Correction for the safekeeping of said prisoners; and in the event of Vacancies in any vacancy occurring in the Managing Com- or Visiting 30 mittee or in either of the said Visiting Com- Committees mittees from death, resignation, absence or any other cause in the interval between two general annual meetings, the Managing Committee shall nominate and appoint any mem-35 bers or member of the said Association to fill such vacancies in the said Committees respectively; but the non-filling up of such vacan- Non-filling up cies shall not in any way invalidate the pro- not to vitiate ceeding of any of the said Committees: and proceedings. members of any of the said

IX. And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect in any manner or way the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors, or of 20 any person or persons, or of any body politic or corporate, such only excepted as are herein mentioned and provided for.

Public Act.

X. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be deemed a Public Act, and shall be pub- 25 licly taken notice of as such by all Judges, Justices of the Peace and other persons whatsoever without being specially pleaded.
