FARMER WOODWARD'S AIRSHIP.

Coming This Way When It Comes, All the Way from the Pacific.

Robert J. Woodward, a farmer of Ventura county, is preparing to sail from San Diego to New York in a balloon.

Mr. Woodward is an enthusiast on the subject of aerial navigation, and for ten years has been in the habit of making excursions in the theory of the navigation of the atmosphere.
