An Act to prevent accidents on Railways in this Province.

WHEREAS the straying of cattle on public highways, intersected or Preamble. touched by Railways, often causes accidents greatly endangering the lives of passengers, and the destruction of property, and also tends to impair the usefulness of such Railways; And whereas it is ne-5 cessary for the safety of travellers and others that a remedy should be provided: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. So much of any Act or law now in force in this Province as may be Inconsistant inconsistent with the enactments hereinafter made, shall be repealed by enactments rethe passing of this Act.

II. From and after the passing of this Act, horses, cattle, sheep, Animals not to goats, swine and other animals, shall not be allowed to run at large on be at large on any public or other highway, intersected, crossed or touched by any roads near railway in this Province, nor on any public road or highway which is not so touched, crossed or intersected, within four miles on either side of 15 any railway.

III. Any such cattle, horses, sheep, goats or other animals found so Such animals running at large or straying on any such highway may, by any person may be imor persons, be impounded in the public Pound nearest to the place at pounded, and which they shall be found so straying; and for each animal so impoundexcept on pay20 ed the owner or person claiming such animal or animals impoundment of an aded shall, before he shall get the same out of such pound, pay the sum ditional fine, of two shillings and sixpence per head to the Poundkeeper over and person imabove the usual charges allowed to such Poundkeeper by the By-laws of poundingthem. the Municipality in which the pound is situate in other cases; and 25 the said Poundkeeper shall, after the receipt of the same, when required, pay over the same to the person or persons so impounding said animal or animals, for their own use, and shall be also entitled to charge and take such fees for impounding such cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine and other animals, as in other cases are fixed by such By-laws as aforesaid.

IV. In all cases where cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine and other Recovery of animals are impounded under this Act, in case default is made in pay-such fines if ment of the amount mentioned in the preceding section and the Pound- not paid. keeper's fees as aforesaid, the same proceedings shall be had to collect the same as are now or may hereafter be used in other cases, where 35 cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine or other animals are taken and impounded for doing damage contrary to law in the respective Municipalities in which such cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine or other animals may be so impounded under this Act, with the exception of the proceedings which are taken to fix the amount of damages to be paid.

Pound-keepers bound to collect and pay over the fine.

V. Any Poundkeeper with whom any animal so found running at large contrary to this Act is impounded, is hereby required to take such proceedings as aforesaid to enforce payment of the fine and his fees, and when by sale or otherwise made, to pay over the said fine so levied and made to the person or persons so impounding the animal or animals so found 5 running at large as aforesaid.
