SIR CHARLES DICKENS TO RIDE

HE WILL ACCEPT THE NOMINATION FOR THE FOREST OF DEAN.

Prefering the Troubles of Political Life to the Ease of a Literary Career, Sir Charles Dickens has decided to accept the nomination for the Forest of Dean, a seat in the House of Commons.

LONDON, March 9.—At a meeting held today the council of the Liberals of the Forest of Dean decided to invite Sir Charles Dickens to become the Liberal candidate for member of Parliament for that constituency and said they felt confident of his moral integrity.

Sir Charles spoke and said he had often announced his decision not to return to public life but he had cleared his conscience. No legal process existed by means of which he could be held responsible, and the vindication published in the pamphlet recently issued enabled him to free his mind from the burden of the seat of a literary career. He would therefore consent to become a candidate if the constituency ratified the invitation which the council had extended to him.
