The Alarm Was Sent in to the Firehall By Telephone Exchange. Five Minutes Before McQuade Rang the Bell-Did Electric Wires Cause the Conflagration?

The inquest into the death of Robert Bowry, who was killed at the Globe fire, was resumed by Colonel Johnson last evening.

Some important evidence touching the origin of the fire was adduced, six witnesses were unanimous that the fire started in the upper stories and not in the basement, as sworn to by Watchman McQuade of the Holmes Protective Company.
