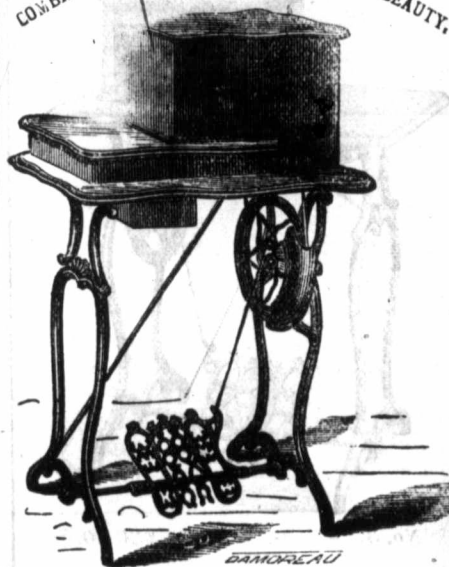

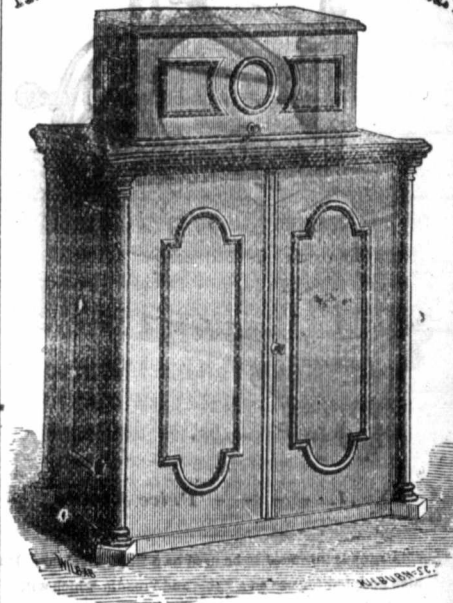

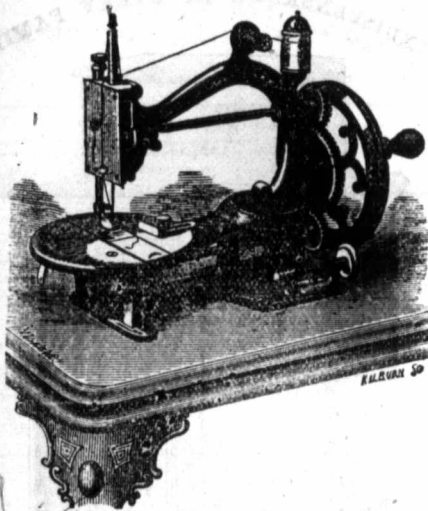

The Corder. For laying and stitching in cord in ladies' clothing, bosoms, collars, cuffs, etc.

The Binder. Our new and improved Adjustable Binder will be found far simpler than any binder heretofore invented. It folds and stitches any width of binding to the edge of the work without basting, and will be found very useful to dress makers, stay makers, vest makers, shoe binders, hat and cap manufacturers, &c. &c.

The Quilter. This is a gauge to attach to the machine as a guide to stitch rows of quilting equidistant.

 Each Machine is sent out threaded, ready for operation, and the directions are so complete that any one can run it successfully without further instructions.
