




Instructions to Architects

Re. Proposed New Court House at Woodstock.

The proposed new Court House for the County of Oxford is to be built in Woodstock, Ontario, in the highest part of the Town, on a lot containing about three acres. The front of the building will be towards the south. The ground in front is nearly level, and falls about three inches in ten feet towards the back.

It would be preferred to have the external walls of the Court House built of stone; the face work of main part of the exterior in random ashlar with pitched joints, or in regular courses worked similar, with bands and other parts of the work treated differently.

The building is to be made as nearly fire-proof as possible, and it is to be heated with steam or hot water, and to be thoroughly ventilated throughout.

Architects competing will be required to furnish plans, sections, and at least three elevations, and specifications, giving a proper description of the materials and work; also plan of basement, showing all heating, sanitary and ventilating arrangements, closets, &c.

The sizes of the different offices and rooms given below are not intended to be binding, only to give those competing an idea of the accommodation required in each—as in carrying out a design it may be necessary to make some of them larger or smaller, but there should be ample space allowed for all the rooms and offices—and all well lighted. The sizes of the rooms are given in square feet, being the area of the floor, and should be as well proportioned as possible. The size of the vaults are also given in internal area. The Committee judged that the internal width should not be less in any case than five feet.

The \$75,000 is intended to include everything necessary or required throughout the building, including heating, lighting, ventilating, and the furnishing for all the rooms—fitting up of vaults, etc. etc.
