It is our painful task to record the very sudden  
death of Lieutenant Colonel Lytton, of the Gren-  
adier Guards, which took place this morning at the  
Globe Hotel. The Lieutenant Colonel arrived  
yesterday in command of the Battalion of Gren-  
adier Guards, and rode at his head from the wharf to  
the Citadel, where he was met by the parade, and though  
very weak, when he alighted at his hotel he was able  
to transact some necessary regimental business and  
retired to bed, expecting to rise in the morning, but  
would enable him to attend the Regimental parade  
in the morning. About eight o'clock his servant  
entered the room, and found that his master was  
no longer alive, but having more attentively, he was  
alarmed at hearing a gurgling sound, and on open-  
ing the curtains found Colonel Lytton at the last  
extremity. Medical aid was immediately called in,  
and was promptly attended to, but the professional  
attendance arrived life was extinct.—Lieut. Colonel  
Lytton entered the Grenadier Guards in 1812, and  
was well known and highly esteemed in the  
country and most fashionable circles of the metrop-  
olis. He was greatly beloved by his brother officers,  
and his untimely death has cast a general  
gloom over the garrison.—*Quebec Mercury.*

On the 28th Sept., at Tynemouth, Mr. George  
Rutherford, merchant, in the 42nd year of his age,  
carrying in a corpse to Tynemouth, Church, and  
died instantaneously in one of the pews. He was  
77 years of age, and had been fifty-five years at sea.  
He was one of the crew of the *Colossus*, at the  
battle of Trafalgar, where he was stationed at  
the second gun on the fore-castle, at which every  
man but himself and Mark Wilson, a native of Lynn,  
in Norfolk, was killed. He was also in the *Vincen-*  
tine, at the battle of Cape St. Vincent, in  
1805, where he was stationed at the foremost gun but one  
on the middle deck.
