It places all the member of the Government on the same plane from the Prime Minister who tolerates Mr. Pugsley presence in the cabinet to the colleagues who are content to sit with him at the counci table.

The so-called Langevin seandals were admirable, compared with the Pugsley scandal et Sir Hector Langevin was retired from the cabinet following revelations which entirely ac quitted him of any suspicion of personal misappropriation of public funds. Hon. Wm. Pugs ley remains serenely in the cabinet, although there is the report of the royal commission
