The plan comprehends the following leading subjects:—Physical geography of the Dominion; climate and climatic effects; geological features; travel and transportation; agriculture, forestry and mining industries; commerce, manufactures and fisheries; the inhabitants, government, social status; miscellaneous; the whole illustrated with upwards of two hundred colored engravings on steel, chromolithography, wood cuts, &c.—A work so wide and at the same time minute must demand a personal knowledge of the separate provinces of the Dominion, as well as an acquaintance with the unexplored wilderness comprised within its borders, and in this respect its author, Prof. Hind, is eminently qualified for its task. He has long been known to the literary public in England and America, and from his personal observations in almost all parts of the Dominion has enjoyed rare opportunities to collect the materials for the present work. It will be printed on 1,200 pages of toned paper, imperial octavo form; to be begun in January next, and issued serially during the year, and completed in about twenty-five parts at 50 cents each; or in five divisions at \$2.50 each.

#### BECKWITH COUNCIL.

The Municipal Council of Beckwith met pursuant to adjournment at the Town Hall on the 11th day of Nov., 1873, at ten of the clock a. m. All the Council present.

The minutes of the last meeting of Council were read and signed by the Mayor. Original communications presented and read. The Mayor of the Municipality of Hamilton dated the 25th October last, enclosing a letter from Crown Land Department of the Province of Ontario, dated the 22nd September, 1873, and addressed to Daniel Galt, Esq., Mayor of Hamilton, in reply to a communication from the Council of Hamilton, and in reference to the establishment of permanent monuments on the disputed town line between Beckwith and Hamilton at lot No. 23 in the 12th concession; and in absence of any special authoritative Statute for the Commissioner of the Crown Land Department to act in such cases, recommending the application in the proper quarter, through the County Council, under the 11th Section of the Act 22 Vic. Cap. 93, Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada; but as the County Council will hold no more ordinary sessions this year, the Council took action, in the meantime, in the matter.

#### COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANARK.

The competitive examination of the public schools in the township of Lanark was held in Middleville on Friday last, the 7th inst. Eight out of the ten sessions (with school houses situated within the township) were represented by pupils. Of the thirty-three candidates who presented themselves for examination sixteen belonged to the 2nd, twelve to the 3rd, and five to the 4th class. The subjects of examination were reading, writing, dictation, arithmetic, grammar and geography. A large number of parents and others were present throughout the day, and seemed to be deeply interested in the trial that was going on. The trustees of the Middleville school were exceedingly attentive to the guests, and extended their hospitality to the supply of cakes, etc., to the children, and a dinner to the examiners at the Village Inn. Very handsome prizes—selected by the County Inspector at the Education Dept. in Toronto—were presented to the successful candidates. Foremost among these was a large and handsomely bound copy of Webster's unabridged English dictionary, which was given to the first pupil in general proficiency in 4th class work. The trophy was carried off by Master William Muir, of the Middleville school, who was closely followed by the second prize winner, Archibald Campbell, of Beckwith. The Middleville school, taught by Archibald Rankin, with Miss Caroline Williams, assistant, succeeded in carrying off the greatest number of prizes; while Nos. 3 and 9, taught by Miss Mitchell and Mr. Campbell, respectively, came off second best. After the examination the very appropriate remarks were addressed to the parents and children by the Rev. Messrs. Cochrane and Brown of Middleville. These gentlemen were present

throughout the day, and expressed themselves as perfectly satisfied with the manner in which the examination had been conducted, and with the results. They dwell particularly on the state impartiality which had been observed, and the good which was likely to accrue from the competition. At the conclusion the Rev. of the Municipality, Mr. Atfield, proposed a vote of thanks to the Examiners, which was heartily rendered.

CARLETON PLACE NOV. 19, 1873.

The town of Winnipeg has improved rapidly during the past year, and has equally good prospects for the future. Incorporation of the town is asked for drainage, gas works, and street lighting are projected; a new steamboat line, three new mills, three tug-boats for the lower river, a foundry, testing coal veins recently discovered on the Souris River, erection of Government buildings, establishment of a Land Office, new Custom House, new Post Office, and building a bridge across the river, are all confidently expected. The rapid increase of the population is a feature of interest, indicating rapid settlement. In October 71, the population only reached 700 souls; in October '72, it had attained 1,500; while in October '73, it more than doubled the preceding year, and reached 3,500. The buildings which were erected last summer were of a better class than formerly, many of them being of brick, a good quality of which is now manufactured. Some 300 are all were erected. The business houses also largely increased, and now comprise sixteen general stores, four groceries, four hardware stores, a bookstore, three bakeries, two fur-stores, two saddler's shops, two watchmaker shops, three drug stores, two watchmaker shops, a gunsmith's shop, three blacksmith's shops, one carriage factory, and four saw mills. Our informant says all are doing a good business. The trade by flat-boats amounted, during the season just closed, to about fifty thousand dollars.

Our exchanges from the United States, say that everywhere there are indications that a decrease in the wages of the working classes is inevitable. It is hard to cut down a man's income at a time like the present, but it is clear that the shrinkage of values and the fall of gold must bring down wages, however much we may regret that result. The organs of capital are, of course, pleased with this prospect, forgetting that high wages means the prosperity of trade, and that men who with high wages can purchase shawls for their wives and groceries for their table are restricted when wages are low to the purchase of the bare necessities of life. There will be much dissatisfaction and not a little distress among workmen this winter, but they should remember that labor has profited for some years past by the inflation of values, and that it is the inevitable law of political economy that labor must also share in the loss brought about by a general shrinkage. Coal, which has been made artificially dear by the combined efforts of the mine owners and the railways—whose interest are in most cases identical—must necessarily share in the general fall of prices. Not only have many large manufacturers ceased work, but the results of the panic will be shown this winter in a decrease of the demand for coal for domestic purposes; economy in fuel being one of the first efforts of those who undertake retrenchment. It follows that coal is to be comparatively cheap this winter, and that those who laid in their annual supply last summer have made a mistake. On the other hand, persons who have not done so are to be congratulated, and they will probably show their wisdom by deciding to buy coal in large quantities until it has materially fallen in price.

There is a new kind of ghost on the New York Central Railroad who is occupied just at present in harassing Engineers. He frequently appears at night time with a red signal lantern and by vigorously waving it stops the express train, only to vanish without assigning any reason for his conduct. At other times, he leaves his arms or legs, detached from his body by the side of the track, or throws himself while it is under full headway. The engineer who stops to pick up the supposed bits of severed passenger, of course finds nothing to reward his search and is compelled to believe that he has run over nothing more substantial than a ghost. The only explanation that can be given of this affair is that the host was formerly a railway director.
