Most Gracious Sovereign,

WHEREAS by Messages from His Excellency the Right Honorable James, Earl of Elgin and Kincardine, Gover-nor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, bearing date respectively the Thirty-First day of May and the Eleventh day of June, in the year One Thousand Eight llundred and Fifty-Three, and the Estimates accompanying the same, laid before both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, it appears that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Three, not otherwise provided for by law, and also for defraying the Cost of certain Public Works, and for other purposes in the said Message and Estimates mentioned:

'Gy it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, In Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue -fund of this Province, there shall and may be paid and applied um not exceeding in the whole the sum of Five Hundred and Sixty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine sing the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province, for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty-Two, and other purposes, set forth in the Schedule to this

- II. And be it enacted, That from and out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Jesuits' Estates Fund, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding Four Thousand Pounds currency, towards the support of certain Educational Institutions in Lower Canada, as set forth in the Schedule aforesaid.
- III. And be it enacted, That from and out of the unappropriated moneys, forming part of the Upper Canada Building Fund, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding Ten Thousand Pounds currency, for completing and furnishing the Normal School at Toronto, as set forth in the Schedule aforesaid.
- IV. And be it enacted, That the due application of the moneys hereby appropriated shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors through the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors shall direct.
- V. And be it enacted, That a detailed account of the moneys expended under the authority of this Act shall be laid before the Legislative Assembly of this Province, during the first fifteen days of the Session of Parliament next after such Expenditure.
