REPORT OF COUNCIL

—OF THE—

DOMINION OF CANADA RIFLE ASSOCIATION,
FOR 1868.

MAY 5TH, 1869.

In presenting the First Annual Report of the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association, the Council feel that they have a right to congratulate the members on the success which has attended its inception and its course up to the present time.

The list of affiliated Societies has been far larger than was at first anticipated. Nearly all of these have intimated their intention of maintaining their connection with the Association ; and enquiries concerning, and proposals for, affiliation warrant the Council in believing that the number of branch Societies will be very largely increased before the close of the current year.

Amongst the present subscribing societies, numbering thirty-three, there has been divided the large sum of \$7,800 according to ratio in respect to the number of members whose names have been returned by the several Societies. As the sums presented to each of these Societies nearly trebles that which has respectively been paid by them to the Association, a direct money inducement is offered in addition to the other advantages attending connection with the Dominion Association to affiliating Societies.

The first annual Prize meeting was held at Laprairie, in the Province of Quebec, commencing on the 15th of

September, and extending over the seven succeeding days. At this meeting the large sum of \$5,155 was distributed in money prizes, besides badges amounting in value to \$300. In this sum is included the cost of a piece of plate of the value of eight hundred dollars, which was competed for by fifteen picked marksmen from each of the Provinces forming the Dominion of Canada, which was won by the Province of Quebec. In addition to these amounts a valuable and beautiful Challenge Cup was presented by Mrs. P. L. MACDOUGALL; and a small cup by a gentleman of Montreal, which was offered for competition to Medical Officers of the Active Force of the Militia.

The Council regret that the inclemency of the weather and the lateness of the season detracted from the numbers of the competitors at this meeting, which, at an earlier period of the year would doubtless have been more largely attended.

A list of the various matches at the meeting, tabulated statements of scores, prizes, &c., will be appended to the Report of the Council when adopted, and distributed when printed to the members of the Association.

The Council especially congratulate the Association that at a meeting so extensive as that at Laprairie, the arrangements were so carried out that not a single accident occurred; and that the general conduct and soldier-like bearing of the Volunteer Militia in Camp was reported by the Officer in military command to the Adjutant General as being beyond all praise.

The Council beg to refer for detailed statement of the Finances of the Association to the Treasurer's Statement, which with the Report of the Auditors and of the Secretary they have appended to this Report.

The liberality of the City of Montreal, which subscribed the sum of \$3,068 to the funds of the Association, is gratefully acknowledged by the Council. It is earnestly to be

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hoped that the other large Cities, and Municipalities of the Dominion in general, will proportionately follow this munificent example, and constitute a reserve fund for the Association, which will enable the Council to extend its scheme of operations.

Past experience leads the Council to recommend that in future, that the Annual Prize Meeting should be held at least one month earlier than on the last occasion—that the money appropriated for competition should be divided into smaller and therefore more numerous prizes ;—and especially urge that a larger proportion of money should be devoted to the encouragement of marksmen using the National Military Weapon, as a general proficiency in the use of this arm among the population of the Dominion may be considered one of the main bulwarks of its defence.

The Council would strongly recommend that Affiliating Societies should, when feasible, hold at least one of their meetings in each year, previously to the Dominion meeting, in order to ensure a fair representation of the best marksmen of the year as competitors in Provincial and District Matches.

The Council, whilst thankfully acknowledging the aid which has been afforded by the Government of the Dominion to the Association through the exertion of the Honorable the Minister of Militia and Defence, would respectfully urge its claims to continued support on the liberality of the Administration.

During the past year the departure from the Dominion of His Excellency LORD MONCK deprived the Association of his distinguished patronage ; but the Council is justified in being able to inform the members that His Excellency SIR JOHN YOUNG, K.C.B., has been pleased to signify his high approval of the object of the Association, to accept of the position as Patron, and to promise his support.

The Council have to acknowledge the very important services rendered to the work of the Association by the Secretary, LT.-COL. STUART, and in the onerous duties of Treasurer, LT.-COL. POWELL has proved the wisdom of the Association in the selection of that Officer for the responsible position.

The Council feel that they cannot in justice close this Report without a full expression of thanks for the unwearied support and encouragement afforded to it by the Adjutant General of the Dominion, COLONEL MACDOUGALL, whose services, it is to be trusted, may long be retained in the country.

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REPORT OF THE SECRETARY

OF THE

Dominion of Canada Rifle Association.

The attention of the ADJUTANT GENERAL of the Militia of Canada having been drawn to the desirability of the formation of a Dominion Rifle Association by numerous persons, amongst whom was DR. HOWITT of Guelph, whose exertions in this respect are deserving of all consideration, and the Adjutant General feeling convinced that such an association would form a great incentive to the male part of the population of the Dominion of Canada, to make themselves thoroughly conversant with the use of the rifle and perfect themselves in the art of shooting, obtained the authority of the Government to call a meeting at Ottawa of persons interested in rifle shooting.

Invitations to attend this meeting were issued throughout the Provinces, and deputations from Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, assembled at Ottawa on the 1st April, 1868, and following days, and the meetings were also largely attended by members of the Senate and House of Commons interested in rifle shooting, and connected with the Militia and Volunteer Militia force of the country.

The members to form a Council, together with the President and other officers having been chosen, it was decided that His Excellency the Governor General, VIS-COUNT MONCK, should be requested to become Patron,—to which he was pleased to accede.

Invitations were issued to the Lieut.-Governors of the several Provinces, the Lieut.-General commanding the

Forces, and also the Ministers, &c., &c., to become Vice-Patrons, and the names of those that assented have been duly published.

At a meeting of the Council under the presidency of Lieut.-Colonel the Hon. A. E. BOTSFORD, it was agreed to draw up a programme for a meeting for the competition for such prizes as the amount of funds at their disposal justified them in offering to be contended for, and it was arranged that the first meeting of the Association should take place at or near Montreal, where it was expected that the well known liberality of that city would supplement the prize list with a considerable subscription.

The Government, through the Honorable the Minister of Militia, Sir. G. E. CARTIER, Bt., authorized a grant of \$5,000 in aid of the funds of the Association, and the subscription list embraced the names of His Excellency the Governor General and other liberal subscribers.

The Rules of the Association were framed with a view of holding out strong inducements to encourage the formation of affiliated associations throughout the Dominion, and thirty-three associations thus connected themselves with the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association.

It having been decided that Laprairie Common near Montreal was the locality best suited for carrying out a meeting upon a large scale, arrangements were made to obtain the use of the ground and barracks for the purpose, and MAJOR SCOBLE of the 37th Battalion, V. M., was intrusted with the erection of Butts, and making such provision for carrying out a meeting on a large scale as was considered necessary by the sub-committee under whose directions he acted.

The prize list was published and offered the sum of \$5,155 for competition.

In addition to the above, a prize consisting of a Cup,

valued at \$200, was presented by MRS. MACDOUGALL, the wife of the Adjutant General of Militia, to be contended for as a challenge cup under certain conditions. The winner on this occasion was DR. MAY, a private in the 19th Battalion, V. M., residing at St. Catharines, Ontario.

Another prize, the gift of a member of the profession, was presented, to be contended for by medical gentlemen, members of the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association, and was won by DR. BUNTING, New Brunswick Militia Artillery.

The following number of entries were made for the several prizes:—

The competitors from New Brunswick and Nova Scotia laboured under very considerable disadvantages, inasmuch as they had had little or no practice with the Snider-Enfield Rifle, nevertheless the competitors from New Brunswick won prizes to the amount of \$225, and those from Nova Scotia the amount of \$380, which included the first prize of the All-comers' International.

The first prize in the Provincial match, being a piece of plate worth \$800, was won by the competitors representing the province of Quebec.

By command of H. E. the Commander-in-Chief a camp was formed at Laprairie, for the purpose of maintaining discipline, &c., and affording tent accommodation to the Militia who were competitors.

The number of competitors who availed themselves of

the tent accomodation provided for them, amounted to nearly 700, and a very considerable number lodged in the village of Laprairie, and at Montreal.

Arrangements were made for provisioning the men at two restaurants, one within the Barrack enclosure, and the other in the vicinity of the ranges.

Unfortunately the weather during the greater portion of the meeting was cold, wet, and stormy, and on one day no shooting could take place, and on several days the shooting was delayed on account of the unfavorable state of the weather.

The Honorable the Minister of Militia, Sir. G. E. CARTIER, Bt., paid a visit to the camp, accompanied by a number of distinguished visitors, and watched the shooting with considerable interest.

The expenses of conducting the meeting was necessarily very great, it being requisite to erect butts and lay out the ranges especially for this meeting, which it was considered should not extend over too long a period, and that therefore every facility should be given to enable the competitions to be carried on as expeditiously as possible.

The markers were furnished from the line regiments quartered at Quebec and Montreal, and were under command of CAPTAIN LE FEUVRE, 16th regiment.

It is with the greatest satisfaction I have the pleasure to state, that the meeting, which extended over eight days, passed off without the slightest accident of any description.

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R U L E S .

- 1.—That this Association be denominated "THE DOMINION OF CANADA RIFLE ASSOCIATION."
- 2.—Any person being a subscriber of \$2.00 per annum shall become a Member of the Association.
- 3.—Donors of \$40.00 at one time to the funds of the Association, or of a Prize of not less value, to be competed for at the Annual Prize Meeting, shall be entitled to be enrolled as Life Members of the Association.
- 4.—Any Rifle Association of the Dominion subscribing not less than \$40.00 annually to the funds of the Dominion Rifle Association, shall be considered as being in connection with it, and shall be entitled to a number of Memberships in the proportion of one to every Dollar thus subscribed. Each subscribing Association is to elect from its members the persons to hold such Memberships, and return their names and addresses, when elected, to the Secretary of the Dominion Rifle Association, to be registered by him one month previous to the Match.
- 5.—There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons named by the Council.
The Governor-General of the Dominion of Canada for the time being shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron."
- 6.—There shall be a President.
- 7.—There shall be Vice-Presidents.
- 8.—There shall be a Council of Forty-two Members, who shall be elected in the following proportions :

Sixteen, [16] from Ontario,
Twelve, [12] " Quebec,
Seven, [7] " New Brunswick,
Seven, [7] " Nova Scotia,

of whom four shall form a quorum, and who shall be elected, primarily by the Delegates now assembled at Ottawa, and hereafter at the Annual Meeting,—and the General Meetings of the Council shall be held at the Capital of the Dominion.
- 9.—The Council shall choose from the members elected the President of the Association.

- 10.—There shall be a Vice-President for each Province, selected from among the Members of the Association, and who shall be elected by the Council.
- 11.—The Presidents of the various Provincial Associations in connection with this Association, and the Militia Staff Officers in charge of the several Militia Districts of the Dominion, being members thereof, shall be *ex-officio* Vice-Presidents, and all Vice-Presidents shall be members of the Council.
- 12.—There shall be a Treasurer, and there shall be a paid Secretary at Ottawa, both to be appointed by the Council, and holding office during pleasure.
- 13.—The Council shall have the sole management of the income and funds of the Association, rendering an account to the yearly meeting,—such account having been previously audited by a person or persons not members of the Council, who shall be annually named by the Council for that purpose. The Council shall also have the entire management and superintendence of all the affairs and concerns of the Association, and shall or may do all such acts and deeds as shall appear to them necessary or essential to be done for the purpose of carrying into effect the object and views of the Association.
- 14.—The Council shall be regulated in their proceedings by such By-laws as may from time to time be enacted by them;—no By-law being in any case altered, or new one proposed, without at least one month's notice of such intention being given to each member of Council.
- 15.—The Annual Prize Meeting shall be held alternately in the several Provinces of the Dominion, at such times and places as may be determined on by the Council.
- 16.—The Prizes shall be competed for in accordance with such Regulations as may be passed by this Council from time to time.
- 17.—An Annual Report, embracing the audited account of the Finances, shall be drawn up by the Secretary, and shall (having been previously submitted to the Council) be published as soon after the Prize Meeting as may be found practicable.
- 18.—There shall be an Annual Meeting to be held at such time as shall be selected by the Council.

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Annual Meeting.

The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be held at Ottawa on the Third Wednesday after the assembling of the General Session of the Parliament of the Dominion.

Meetings of Council.

There shall be two Ordinary Meetings of the Council. The first of which shall be held on the day after the Annual Meeting of the Association, and the second at such other time as the Council may then determine upon.

Extraordinary Meetings.

Extraordinary Meetings shall be summoned by the Secretary if required by any six of the members of the Council,—notification being sent to each member of Council at least fifteen days previous to such meeting,—and the requisition for the Meeting, and the notices to the members, must state the object or objects of such Extraordinary Meeting.

The Council to keep minutes of all proceedings.

The Council shall keep minutes of its proceedings at all meetings, which shall be entered in a book kept for that purpose by the Secretary,—and open to inspection of any members of the Council.

Finance Committee.

There shall be a Finance Committee, consisting of three members of the Council.

Treasurer to deposit sums received in Savings Bank.

The Treasurer is authorised to deposit from time to time in the Savings Department of the Ontario Bank all sums of money paid over to him on behalf of the Association.

Expenditure of sums for current expenses.

All expenditure of sums for current expenses which may be required by the Secretary must be authorized by the signature of the President of the Association, or in his absence by some member of the Finance Committee, and the Treasurer shall pay all orders duly signed in such manner.

Expenditures of a general nature.

Other expenditures of a general nature are to be made only upon the authority of the Council of the Association.

Annual accounts.

A detailed statement of all Receipts and Expenditures shall be rendered annually to the Council by the Treasurer.
