ORDER OF SERVICE

AT MEETINGS OF THE

CHURCH UNION.

The Person officiating shall say :

Let us call upon the name of the Lord.

V. Holy, Holy, Holy. Lord God Almighty.

R. Which was, and is, and is to come.

V. Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power.

R. For Thou hast created all things, and for Thy pleasure they are and were created.

O LORD, we draw near unto Thee, acknowledging our unworthiness: and we beseech Thee that all the sins, offences, and neglects of the past may be freely pardoned, and entirely done away, through the precious Blood of Thy dear Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

O GOD and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, we humbly offer ourselves, and all the unworthy service we can render, to the unspeakable compassion

of Thy love. We commend it to Thee to correct, to guide, and to perfect it. Purify our intentions, and uphold our weakness for Thy mercy's sake, through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
