ORDER OF SERVICE

AT MEETINGS OF THE

CHURCH UNION.

The Person officiating shall say :

Let us call upon the name of the Lord.

V. Holy, Holy, Holy. Lord God Almighty.

R. *Which was, and is, and is to come.*

V. Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power.

R. *For Thou hast created all things, and for Thy pleasure they are and were created.*

Let us pray.

O LORD, we draw near unto Thee, acknowledging our unworthiness : and we beseech Thee that all the sins, offences, and neglects of the past may be freely pardoned, and entirely done away, through the precious Blood of Thy dear Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. *Amen.*

O GOD and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, we humbly offer ourselves, and all the unworthy service we can render, to the unspeakable compassion

of Thy love. We commend it to Thee to correct, to guide, and to perfect it. Purify our intentions, and uphold our weakness for Thy mercy's sake, through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Then shall be read the following Lesson:

Romans xii. 9—16.

LET love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good. Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. Bless them which persecute you; bless, and curse not. Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and

weep with them that weep. Be of the same mind one towards another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate.
