The proprietors of the Montreal Courier beg to state, that they have just completed their arrangements for the reception of the latest news from the East of England, (Toronto), and that full details of all the affairs and doings in the Dominion will always appear in the columns of their journal.

The precautions entered into by the Government of France and Russia to check the export of produce from those countries, and the doubts expressed by the Continental papers as to a satisfactory produce remaining to provide for the wants of the people, afford collateral evidence that the prices have touched the lowest point in the English markets.

The above figures exhibit a serious decline in the quantity of produce, not explained upon any other ground than that the stocks are exhausted.
