PROVINCIAL POLITICS.—It is very singular how rapidly changes of views follow-changes of circumstances. A few weeks ago three was nothing so vile, in the judgment of the present Ministerial party, as a change of sides on the part of politicians having seats in Parliament. Yet these gentlemen, recently sin horrified at the idea of party desertion, so convinced that the Ministers of the day were attempting to buy up their opponents, and so resolute in believing that every apparent change, even though made in the direction upon the whole germane to the views entertained during a lifetime by the person making it, must be the result of a vile bargain, are now boasting of a majority which can only be had, if had at all, by the means of refugees from the party now in opposition. This view of the case does not strike them as being quite so shocking as did a similar spectacle afew weeks age. Their present moral sense has grown less ticklish and more robust. If they can only get the majority they will ask no questions as to the means. Whether they will do so is another matter. Some four or five names have been mentioned as those of persons who, by deducting as many votes from the Opposition, and carrying them over to the Ministerial side, will secure to the latter a majority of eight or ten. But making all allowances for the tendency of men to join the side which for the moment seems to be the strongest, it is difficunt to believe that those who have heard somuch contempt expressed for turn costs will be very ready to expose themselves to the same sort of censure.
