News of Mines From Grand Forks

Negotiations Still Pending for Sale of the Seattle Mine.

Party of Granby Smelter Director are Expected on a Visit.

Grand Forks, Nov. 14.—The dancing club which was organized here on Halloween at a dance given in the Yale Hotel, has issued invitations for an informal dance to be given on Thanksgiving night in the Yale Hotel.

The Canadian Pacific Railway Company is at present surveying the flats between the river and the C. P. R. station into acre lots, which are being purchased very rapidly for small farms and market gardens.

The force of men at work on the wagon road to Skyline Camp, under Mr. G. Findlay, has completed the work of building the road, and the various claims in that camp have now easy and direct communication with the smelter.

James F. Hill, the Colorado smelter man, who has been in the city for some time, left here on Saturday for his home in Colorado. Before leaving Mr. Hill stated emphatically that the Franklin Camp properties, in his opinion, far exceed the mineral showings of the Phoenix Camp.

Robert Clark, an old-time mine-owner, has just returned from Spokane, where negotiations are being conducted for the purchase of the famous Seattle mine, some eight miles up the North Fork of the Skagit River.

F. M. Holland, president of the Kettle Valley line railway, who has been in the city a few days ago, will remain for a short time, and it is expected that he will make a tour of inspection over the proposed line of his railway up the North Fork.

James F. Hill, the Colorado smelter man, who has decided to erect a customs smelter here, has already secured contracts for a daily tonnage of 700 tons of ore. He is still working on the matter of securing increased tonnage, so that he will know exactly what he is doing when he starts to erect the smelter.

A number of the head directors of the Granby smelter are expected to arrive here shortly to inspect the Granby holdings at Grand Forks. The party consists of George Martin, treasurer of the New York, secretary-treasurer of the Nichols Chemical Co., Jacob Langlois, president of the Nichols Chemical Co., of New York; J. B.
