A New Office on the Tap. Ald. Graham sprung a surprise on the Board by stating that it was rumored that it was the intention to open up a new office, that of Inspector of Fruit. He could not see the use of making a permanent position when at the very outside there would be only three months' work in the year for whoever was appointed.

Ald. Verral: 'This is all nonsense. What do we want with another office, when among his duties there is the inspection of fruit and the inspection of the market? This is simply duplicating offices.'

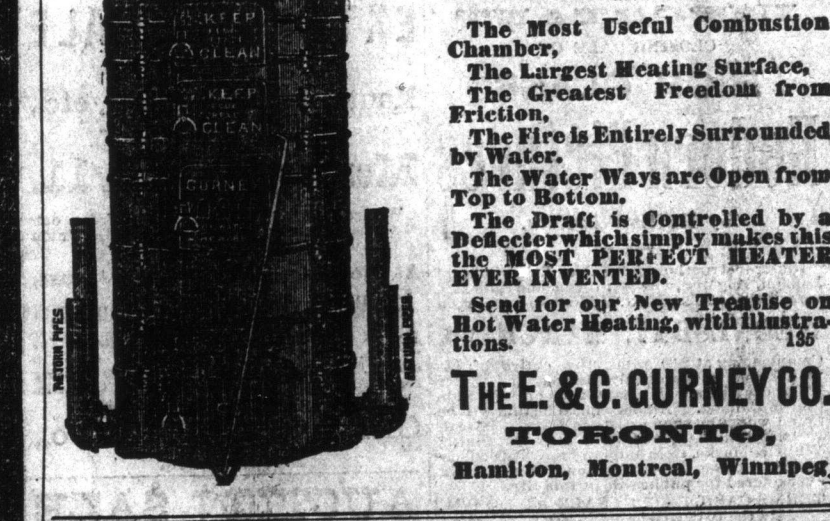
