CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ATÁRIO.

The demand for lumber in Toronto is heavier than usual in midwinter, and prices generally are firm. It has seemed difficult to advance wholesale prices to the same extent as has been done at the mills, but the prevailing opinion is that there will be a moderate rise at least before spring. The outlook is regarded as very bright. Box lumber and mill culls; are now being shipped in considerable quantities from Ontario to the Eastern states, Chicago and Michigan. Numerous inquiries are being received for stock for shipment as soon as navigation opens. Consumers of bardwoods are adding to their stock of raw material apparently believing that it will not be possible to obtain hardwood lumber below present quotations for some time at least. Shingles are higher and sell wholesale in Toronto at \$3 for XXX,\$2 for XX, and \$1 for X. The movemet of lath is light, but the tendency of prices is upwards, and as soon as there is an expansion in demand, quotations will immediately follow the advance which has been put into effect in the Lake Superior and Michigan districts.

The latest reports from the woods go to show that the log cut of the present season is to date behind the figures for the same period one year ago. Natural conditions are held responsible for the shortage.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Predictions are made that there will be a strong demand for spruce lumber during the current year. Building operations throughout the Maritime Provinces promise to be on an unusually large scale, while the projected harbor improvements at Montieal, Quebec and St. John will call for a considerable quantity of timber. The erection of large grain handling facilities at Quebec by Capt. Wolvin, of Duluth, is also an undertaking which will consume a considerable quantity of building material. The Eastern States are likely to purchase liberally, while it is probable that about the usual quantity of spruce deals will find a market in Great Britain. Altogether, manufacturers are disposed to anticipate a favorable season. Clapuonids at the present time are the strongest feature of the market, selling at \$35 for Boston delivery. Cedar shingles are unchanged at \$3.25 to \$3.30 for extras. Spruce lath is weaker, sales having been made for Boston at \$2.90 for 1-5-8 inch.

UNITED STATES.

The lumber business is exceptionally good for this time of the year, with each day adding strength to the position of white pine. In the Lake Superior district the shortage in the supply is an important factor. Some dealers have already advanced the price of piece stuff and No. 1 boards, and it is expected that at the annual meeting of the Mississippi Valley Lumbermen's Association on February 18th, the price list committee willdecide upon an advance in the price of nearly all grades. The official price list of the Saginaw Lumber Dealer's Association, which took effect on January 20th last, shows an advance on pine stocks generally, the greatest increase being, of course, in the upper grades. White pine lath is now quoted by that association at \$3.75 for No. 1 and \$3.25 for No. 2. The supply is light and no person is endeavoring to force sales. The strength of lath. is also shared by shingles. Dealers report that it is simply impossible to get shingles to fill orders. Hemlock lath are firm at \$2.90 for No 1, and \$2.15 for No. z, in car lots. A further improvement is reported in the tone of the hardwood market, and it is believed that within a short time there will be a de ided change for the better in hardword prices. GREAT BRITAIN.

The outlook for shippers of lumber to Great Britain is better than was expected afew weeks ago, although importers are not exhibiting much confidence in the year's operations. It is almost certain that the better grades of pine deals will find a market at remunerative prices. The course of the spruce market, however, is less certain, as it will depend largely upon the extent of imports into Great Britain from the Baltic. If these should prove unexpectedly large and greater than the market can absorb, a slump in spruce prices will likely result. Stocks in London, however, have become considerably reduced during the past two months. The peace proposals that have been made to the British Government are a hopeful sign, and although meeting with refusal, are regarded as indicating that negotiations for a settlement of the South African war will soon be under way.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The city engineer of St. John, N. B., has been instructed to invite tenders for the supply of 2,500 tons of timber for the building of a wharf.

The cooperage market at the present time is quiet. Buyers are not in the market to any extent. In Chicago pork barrels are offered at from 90 to 95 cents.

Mr. Kennedy, of North Brook, Ont., has taken out 20,000 cubic feet of board timber for Burton Bros., of Barrie. The timber was cut on the Drinkwater limits.

During the year 1901 Buffalo dealers imported from Canada 69,212,106 feet of lumber, 44,803,333 hingles, and 12,071,570 laths. These figures show a large increase over those of 1900, which were 43,502,741 feet of lumber, 23,360,400 shingles, and 3,151,400 laths.

In the Chicago market there are many items of white pine lumber that are exceptionally scarce. No. 1 and No. 2 12-inch boards in any length are difficult to get hold of, and everything over 16-foot in both Norway and white pine piece stuff is exceedingly scarce, also 2 x 12 and 3 x 12.

Hon. C. W. Robinson, Capt. Wright and F. C. Robinson, of Moncton, and C. S. Hickman, of Dorchester, N. B., have purchased the mills and 30,000 acres of timber lands from Gillespie Prescott, of Cumberland county, N. S. The property is situated near Shulee, and the purchase price is about \$100,000.

McLachlin Bros., of Amprior, Ont., recently sold about 8,500,000 feet of 12-inch stock to the Shepard & Morse Company for shipment to South America. The martil ship ships a seep states and a

Mr. G. W. Campbell is understood to have entered into an agreement with the Pacific Coast Lumber Company, of New Westminster, B.C., to handle their entire output. This company is now building a mill on Coal Harbor, within the city ilmits of Vancouver.

The R. Laidlaw Lumber Company, of Toronto and Buffalo, are reported to have purchased the entire output of the Hunts-ville Lumber Company's mill for the coming season. This company have purchased largely in Ontario within the last two months.

Inst two months.

The vessel Wetmore, coaded with lumber, recently became atranded at Tohermorey, Bruce county, Ont. The lumber was en route to Buffalo, being the property of Hurd & Hauenstein and Hurd Bros., of that city. It comprised about 2,000,000 feet, of which about four-fifths has been saved and is now offered for sale by the insurance agents. for sale by the insurance agents.

The red shingle situation in Washington is marked by a steady improvement in prices. Clears are bringing about \$1.85, and stars about \$1.65. Stars are stronger in the market than clears, a reversal of the order prevailing near the close of last season. This is attributed to the fact that the poor market for stars which prevailed at that time caused many mills which had been cutting that grade to turn to clears, with the result that the stock of stars has been reduced.

Of the hardwood situation at Buffalo, Of the hardwood situation at Buildo, N. Y., the American Lumberman says: i Dealers find that the demand is improving and the supply is not only small, but is growing smaller right along. While New England is not buying as readily as it might, waiting for more favorable prices, New York State and City are quite in line and will have lumber if they are good it. City are quite in line and will have lumber if they can get it, whether the price is what they want or not, for the outlook is that this state is building as it never did before, taken as a whole, and will keep on building as long as general business may be good. What is going to be done for stock, especially oak, is hard to say. Some dealers, who used to be the standbys in that sort of lumber, say that they are very low in it, while others, who are very inclined to boast of their supply, admit that they are out of this or that, especially certain thick cuts. The demand is more general than it was and calls for all sorts and all cuts, but it will have to be satisfied with what there is. Prices are about as formerly, though some dealers are asking more for oak.

A market report from S. P. Musson,

A market report from S. P. Musson, Son & Company, dated January 18th, cont tins the following reference to the Barbados lumber market: "Arrivals have baroados lumber market: "Arrivais lave-been heavy, and dealers were so fully stocked that a decline was bound to take place, and if further arrivals occur, we shall probably see even lower prices. The
