DROWNED IN A HOLE.

PATRICK MOONEY'S DEATH IN THE GASPAREUX.

No Inquest Held—A Case Which Seems to Require Further Investigation.

St. John, N. B., May 20.—Patrick Mooney, postmaster and general dealer of Gaspereaux, a short distance from here, was drowned in the Gaspereaux stream yesterday, under peculiar circumstances.

It seems that two men, one of whom is named Walter Patterson and Mooney had been enjoying a drinking bout at Mooney's home which is located within a short distance from Gaspereaux station. On Sunday morning about ten o'clock ten neighbors saw Mooney and Patterson walk down the road in the direction of the stream. A dog was thrown over the stream in a rapid set of sight of the houses. Under the bridge and above the bridge there is a deep hole which is frequently used by the boys of the village for bathing. Both men, it is said, were under the influence of liquor when they passed down the road. After the two men passed out of sight Mooney's body was found in the water. He was then dead although he had been under water more than two hours. After pulling the body from the water it was found to be dead.

The neighbors who had seen the men pass down the road saw Patterson stagger up alone, but as he gave no account of the missing man, and that he had seen Mooney, Patterson walked half a mile further up the road to Mooney's house where he was found to be dead.

It is a sad case, and it is to be hoped that the coroner will hold an inquest into the matter.

It is, perhaps, not out of place to say that Mrs. Geo. W. Daniel is the moving spirit in the matter, and that the pleasant evening may be anticipated.
