

TRINITY METHODIST CHURCH

-- REPORT OF --

THE ENVELOPE COMMITTEE



HORTLY after the inception of the work of this Church, and after mature deliberation of the Quarterly Official Board, it was deemed advisable that Trinity Methodist Church should be sustained by purely voluntary principles, and with this end in view the system of voluntary offerings by envelopes (which should include free pews, and all expenses, connexional and otherwise, except Missionary and Sabbath School Offerings) was adopted.

It was believed that the adoption of this system was the only true and scriptural one, for the sustaining of the Ministry and general expenses of the Church, and that such needed only to be brought before and explained to all regular worshippers of this Church, to ensure a hearty and spontaneous response.

The Committee and Church have great reason to feel proud and truly thankful to God "the giver of every good and perfect gift," for the very generous and noble response of its members and attendants in this direction.

We have now on our books 172 contributors, who are making regular weekly offerings, but it is felt that all of our congregation should adopt this principle of divine giving, by regular systematic weekly offerings, contributed through The Envelope System.

Let not the smallness of your offerings, or latent pride hinder you in the consideration of your offerings to the Lord, who loveth a cheerful and responsive giver. Let each of you give as the Lord has prospered you, and your reward will come. "Freely ye have received, freely give."

By reference to the foregoing statements it will be seen that some \$7,500.00 is required yearly to meet the current expenses of the Quarterly and Trustee Boards; to meet this requires an average of \$150.00 per week, and at present our income will not exceed \$120.00, leaving a deficiency which we trust the congregation will make up by weekly systematic offerings.

The amounts given at present, as will be seen by the following statement range from 5 cents to \$6.00 per week. The Committee feel that all who worship with us should give regularly a portion of their earnings, toward the building up of the Kingdom of Christ in our midst and land, and now appeal to all who are able to give of their substance to this end.
