

An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to continue the Acts hereinafter Preamble. mentioned, which would otherwise expire at the end of the present Session; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as 5 follows:

1.
