An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts therein mentioned.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient further to continue the Acts hereinafter mentioned, which would otherwise expire at the end of the present Session; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The Act of Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to enlarge the powers of the Trinity House of Montreal, in certain cases where the public health of the city may be endangered;" the Act passed in the twenty-eighth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "An Act for the prevention and repression of outrages in violation of the Peace on the Frontier of this Province, and for other purposes;" the Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the second year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, and intituled: "An Act for better regulating the Common of the Seigneurie of Laprairie de la Madeleine;" the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the same year of the same reign, and intituled: "An Act to enable the inhabitants of the Seigneurie of La Baie Saint Antoine, commonly called La Baie du Febyre, to provide for the better regulation of the Common in the said Seigneurie," as amended and extended by the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the fourth year of the same reign, and intituled: "An Act to authorize the Chairman and Trustees of the Common of the Seigniory of the Baie Saint Antoine, commonly called the Baie du Febyre, to terminate certain disputes relating to the limits of the said Common, and for other purposes appertaining to the same;" the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the ninth year of the same reign, and intituled: "An Act to alter and amend an Act, passed in the sixth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled: 'An Act to authorize the inhabitants of the Fief Grosbois, in the County of Saint Maurice, to make regulations for the common of the said Fief;" and all and every of the said Acts are hereby continued to the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and from thence until the end of the then next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer.

2. The Act of Parliament of this Province, passed in the seventh year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to repeal an Ordinance of Lower Canada, intituled: 'An Ordinance concerning Bankrupts, and the administration and distribution of their estates and effects,' and to make provision for the same object throughout the Province of Canada," and the Act amending the same, passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to continue and amend the Bankrupt Laws now in force in this Province," in so far as the same are continued by and for the purposes mentioned in the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to make provision for the continuance and completion of proceedings in Bankruptcy now pending," and the said last-mentioned Act;

The period limited by the Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to amend the Act passed to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings," as that within which it shall be lawful for the Registrar of the County of Hastings, to receive and index any memorial, under the authority of the Act of the said Parliament, passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled; "An Act to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings, in Upper Canada," or of the Act of the said Parliament passed in the Session held in the ninth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act to alter and amend an Act intituled: 'An Act to remedy certain defects in the Registration of Titles in the County of Hastings, in Upper Canada,'" or to endorse any Deed, Conveyance, Will or Probate, to which such memorial relates, shall be and is hereby extended to the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and thence until the end of the then next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer. 10 15 20 25

4. And whereas certain Provident Institutions or Savings Banks have been established and are now in operation in this Province, under the conditions, privileges, and restrictions made, granted, and imposed by an Act of Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session thereof held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act to encourage the establishment of and regulate Savings Banks in this Province;" and whereas the time thereby fixed for the continuance and operation of such Savings Banks was extended for the period of five years, by an Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session thereof held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "An Act to continue for a limited time an Act intituled: 'An Act to encourage the establishment of and regulate Savings Banks in this Province;'" and whereas the time thereby limited for the operations of the said Savings Banks was further extended until the thirtieth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, by an Act of the Parliament of this Province passed in the Session thereof held in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "An Act to regulate Savings Banks, and to repeal the Act now in force for that purpose," and subsequently by the seventieth section of chapter fifty-six of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada; and whereas it is expedient that the operations of the said Savings Banks should be further continued for a limited time: Therefore, the said first-cited Act shall continue and remain in force as regards the Savings Banks mentioned in the said seventieth section, until the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, and from thence until the end of the next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer. 30 35 40 45 50

5. Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the effect of any Act passed during the present Session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the Acts hereinbefore mentioned and continued, nor shall continue any provision or part of any of the Acts in this Act mentioned, which may have been repealed by any Act passed during the present Session or in any previous Session. 55
