An Act respecting the County Town of the County of Halton.

WHEREAS the Act of the Parliament of Canada, 16 Victoria Chapter Preamble. 218, which separated the County of Halton from the County of Wentworth, fixed the County Town at "Milton," although petitioned against by a large number of the inhabitants of the County, praying that the 5 Election of the place for the County Seat might be left to a vote of the Rate-payers; And whereas large Petitions have been presented at the present Session, setting forth that "Milton" is not the most fit and convenient place for the County Town, and would not be selected by the Rate-payers of the County, and that as the present Jail has been de-10 clared insufficient by the Government Inspector, and therefore the County will be called on at great expense to erect a new Jail, and they therefore pray that the County Seat may be selected by a vote of the Rate-payers of the County; And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioners. Therefore, Her Majesty &c., enacts as

I. For and notwithstanding any provision of the Act 16 Victoria, Chap- County Town ter 218, the Municipal Electors of the said County of Halton shall select to be chosen the place for the County Town of the said County, at the Annual Muni- by vote of the Municipal cipal Election to be held on the first Monday in January, 1862, and a Electors. 20 Poll shall be opened in each and every Ward, and each duly qualified Municipal Elector present at such Election is hereby empowered to vote for some one place in the County for the said County Town; and the said Polls shall be opened and the votes shall be taken by the several Polls. Returning Officers at the said Municipal Election in the same way under 25 the same provisions, regulations and penalties as they are to, by the Municipal Act to take the votes for Councillors.

II. The Returning Officer for each Ward shall, at the close of the Returning Poll in his Ward, make up in his Poll Book the number of votes recorded officer to reckon up the for each of the several places so voted for in his Ward, and after veri- votes for each 30 fying the correctness of the same before some Justice of the Peace, he place. shall, within three days after the close of the Election, return the said Poll Book to the Clerk of the Municipality.

V. In case of the County Council of the said County shall not, within three months from the receipt of the total votes of the County aforesaid, proceed to erect the necessary County Buildings, it shall and may be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Municipality in which the County Seat shall have been located to proceed to erect the said County Build- 10 ings at their own cost in whole or in part; provided always that any By-Law for such purpose shall be first approved of by the Rate-payers of the Municipality under the terms of the Municipal Act, and whenever the requisite buildings shall have been completed and duly certified to the Warden of the County, under the hand and seal of the head of 15 the Municipality in which the same has been placed, the County Seat shall be removed immediately to the said new County Buildings.

Public Act. VI. This Act shall be a Public Act.
