Preamble.

HEREAS in and by the eighth and ninth Sections of an R W As made in the second Year of his Present Majesty's Reign, Intitled, an Act for the better regulating the Militia on actual Service in Time of War. It is enacted, that when any Part of the Militia shall be ordered to march from one Part of the Province or Town to another, not in the same County to which they belong, on real Service, there shall be allowed and paid to the Com-missioned, non Commissioned Officers, Drummers and Private Soldiers, certains Sums therein mention'd, by which the Militia doing actual Duty within their own Towns and Counties, are excluded from receiving any Pay for that Service.

I. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council, and Affembly, That there shall be paid to all Commissioned, Non-commssiiond Officers, Drummers and Private Men, who shall herefore do actual Duty on real Service, within any Town or County in this Province, for fo long as they shall remain and continue on faid Service the fameRate of pay, asis allowed to be paid by faid Act to the Said Officers, and others doing duty on real Service, not in the fame County, to which they belong.

Provided, that nothing in this act contained, shall take Effect, or be carried into Execution at any Time but on Occasion of actual Invasion, or sudden Attack from an Enemy, or imminent Danger thereof in such Town or County, and that such Militia shall be called on Duty as aforesaid by the commanding Officer, with the Advice and Consent, of at least Two of the Field Officers or Captains residing in said Town or County, and that the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief of the Province shall approve thereof.

Be it Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the publication of this Act, each and every Person, who shall be drawn as a Grand Juror at the Supreme Court, which shall herefore be held for each respective County in this Province, shall serve as such at the said Supreme Court and Courts of General Sessions of the Peace, during one Year from the Time of their being sirst sworn in at either of the said Courts, any Law, Usage or Custom to the contrary Notwithstanding.

Be it Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That if any Person or Persons shall cut down or otherwise destroy any Trees or Underbrush growing within Thirty Feet of ruth on that fidewithe Road of the Land, that lies between the faid Road leading from Halifax to Fort Sackville, on that side next Bedford Bason, shall on Proof thereof, by the Oath of one credible Witness, before one of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace for, the County of Halifax, be convicted, shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Forty Shillings, to be levied by Warrant of Diffress on the Offender's Goods and Chattles, which Fine to levied shall be applied, one Half to the Informer, and the other Half to and for Use of said Road.
