PETER AND THOMAS.

A PASSAGE BETWEEN MESSRS. WHITE AND MITCHELL.

OTTAWA, April 11.—The business of private members had precedence in the commons today.

PARNELL'S POPULARITY.

HIS ADHERENCE TO CONSTITUTIONAL AGITATION.

ARRANGEMENTS PERFECTED FOR RAISING THE TESTIMONY TO HIM—COMPOSITION OF THE DUBLIN COMMITTEE.

DUBLIN, April 11.—Mr. Parnell has lately been growing steadily in popularity among the best classes of the community. His main course in parliament, his refusal to join in constitutional agitation and the schemes of the revolutionists, and, finally, his determination not to leave Ireland for a trip to America in a time like the present, when England, incensed by the doings of the dynamite fanatic, is tempted to saddle Ireland with a perpetual crime, has endeared him to the thinking Irish citizens of all ranks. The project for a testimonial fund, which had rather dragged before it received a new impetus when Lord Mayor Dawson, with his characteristic energy, took hold of the project and set about forming a committee to take charge of the work. Mr. Dawson got together a party of some twenty persons at a big meeting at the Mansion house, he himself being in the chair. The lord mayor presided, and the committee, which is composed of Mr. Sullivan, M.P., was appointed to frame an address to the Irish race at home and abroad. The object of the committee is to collect names for the testimonial fund, and the success of the Parnell tribute may now be considered assured.

POLITICAL CHRONICLE.

THE ONTARIO GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN CONSULTING HIS FRIENDS: SO MANY OF THE COUNTRY MEMBERS ARE COMING TOGETHER.

There is a good deal of dissatisfaction among their own followers in regard to the cabinet. A number want Mr. Crooks to go; there is considerable fire pulling and canvassing for Mr. Wood's position. It is possible to settle all this without offending any of their followers; and then again it may cause trouble.

But then the government are also dependent on the opposition, or rather the orange section of the opposition. An influential officer of the orange grand lodge said yesterday that if the act incorporating the orange section was not passed at Ottawa this session, then Mr. Mowat would remain in power four years more; if it was passed Mr. Mowat must go. That was to be Sir John's reward for putting the bill through.

THE MEMBERS OF THE QUEEN'S OWN TURNED OUT LAST NIGHT FULLY 550 STRONG, HEADED BY THE BAND.

IMAGINARY DYNAMITERS.

HOW THE BRITISH MINISTER WAS SWINDLED.

HE PAYS A MAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS TO SEARCH SOME MYSTICAL PERSONAGE WHO THOUGHT TO BLOW HIM UP IN AMSTERDAM.

WASHINGTON, April 11.—A few days ago the Hon. Sackville West, the British minister, was visited by Zall Hoover, a well-known character in police circles of this city, and informed him that his residence here was about to be blown to atoms. "How?" inquired Mr. West. "Why," said Hoover, "there are in this city quite a large and respectable number of Irish dynamiters, and they are now fixing, if they have not already planned, dynamite around your house. I know whereof I speak, I think I can find out all about it."

"I would be very much pleased if you would assist me in finding out all about the matter," said West. "It will cost money to do it," said Hoover. "How much?" "Five hundred dollars—I will have to employ some help." This seemed to satisfy Mr. West and he paid the money then and there.

Hoover left and employed two of the detectives to assist him in finding the dynamiters, who were preparing to blow the residence of the British minister. The employment of the detectives of course was a mere blind on the part of Hoover, who had put this up simply to rob Mr. West. The two detectives, armed with a letter from Mayor Morgan, called on Mr. West and learned that he paid to Hoover, five hundred dollars for his services in preventing his residence and his family from being blown to kingdom come by the dynamiters.

The detectives told Mr. West that, in their opinion, he had been galled; that there was no truth in the story, and that Hoover had been playing a similar kind of trick on people in this city for years. The minister inquired what he could do with Hoover, and found that he could probably have him arrested and taken before a judge, but it would be very hard to convict him of the offence, whereupon the Hon. Lionel Sackville West concluded to let the matter drop and his money go.

CANADIAN TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

Quebec seminary is about to establish a large cheese factory on its model farm in Montserrat county.

Several companies in the Quebec district, and notably of Montserrat and L'Isle, intend to erect permanent buildings for their annual agricultural exhibition.

A religious society at Quebec, styled the Holy Infancy, is said to have expended \$50,000 since its foundation in 1852 for the purchase and christening of heathen children, especially in China.
